3. FiLMiC Pro



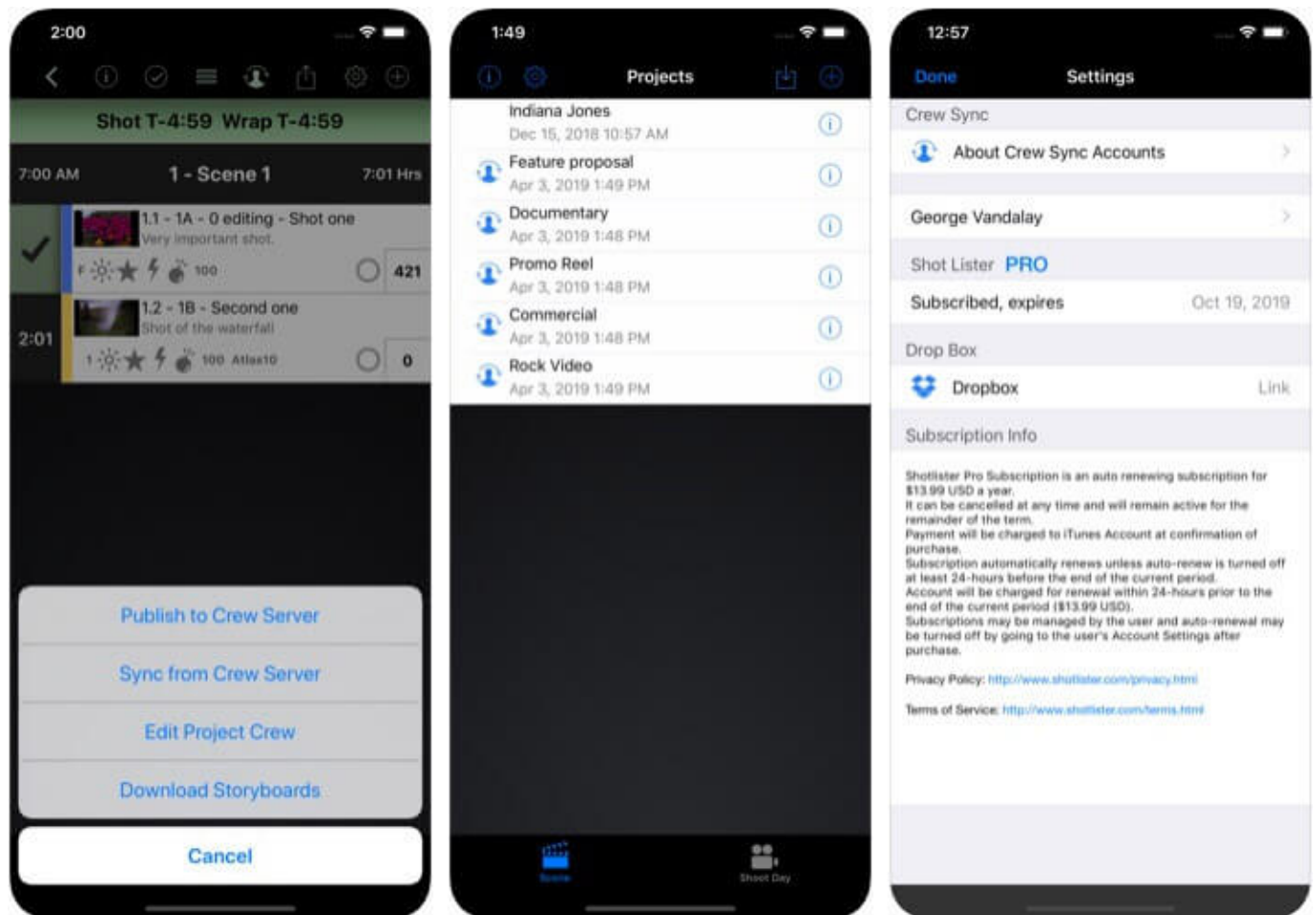

4. Shot Lister



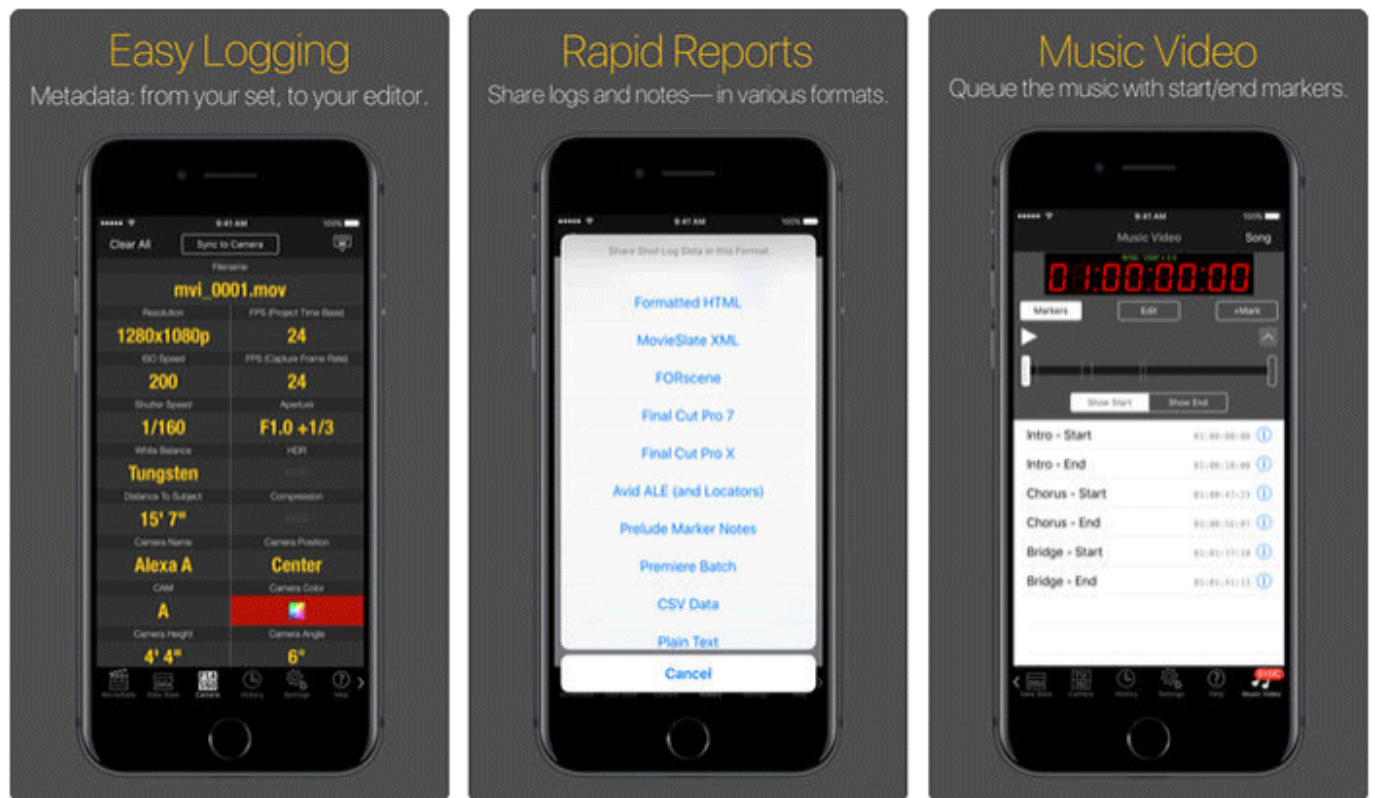

6. ProRemote



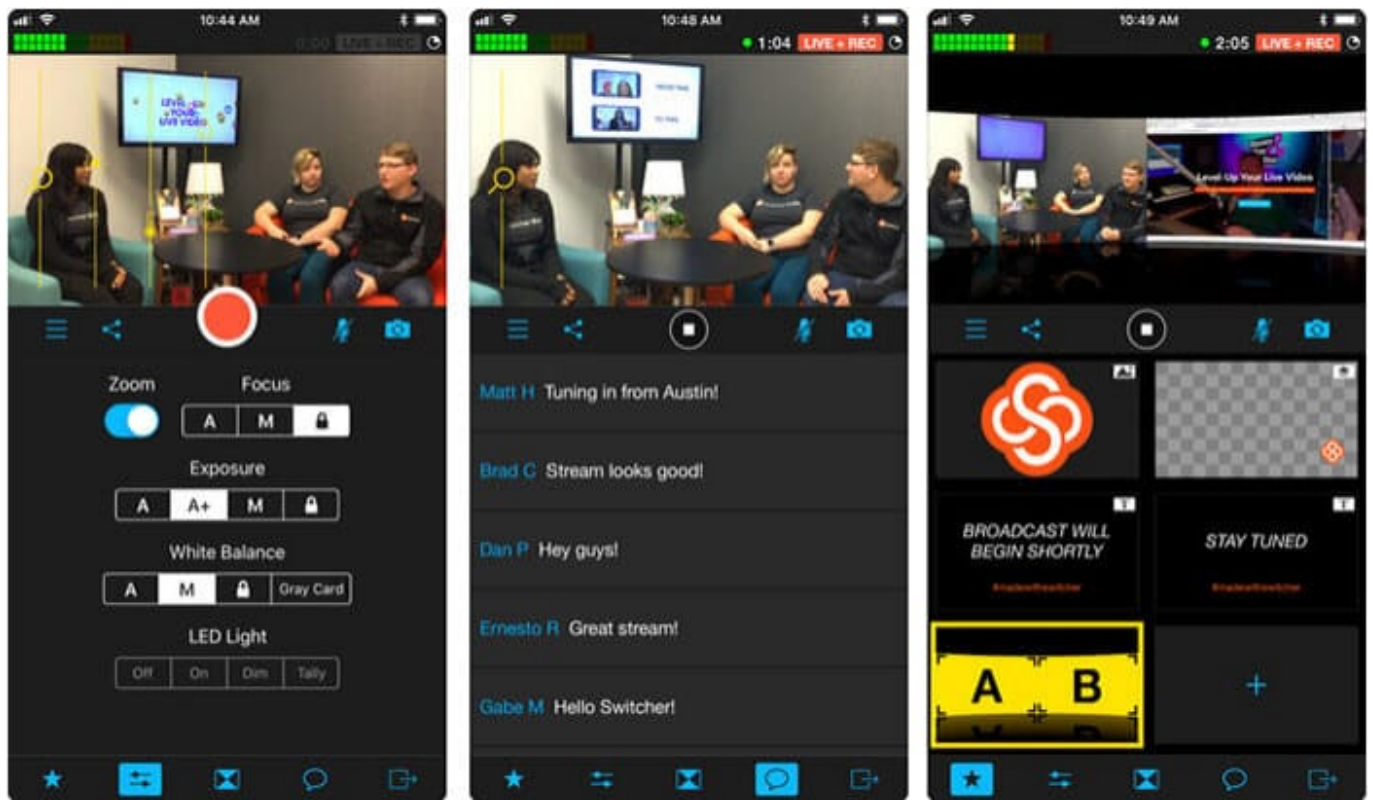

7. Switcher Studio



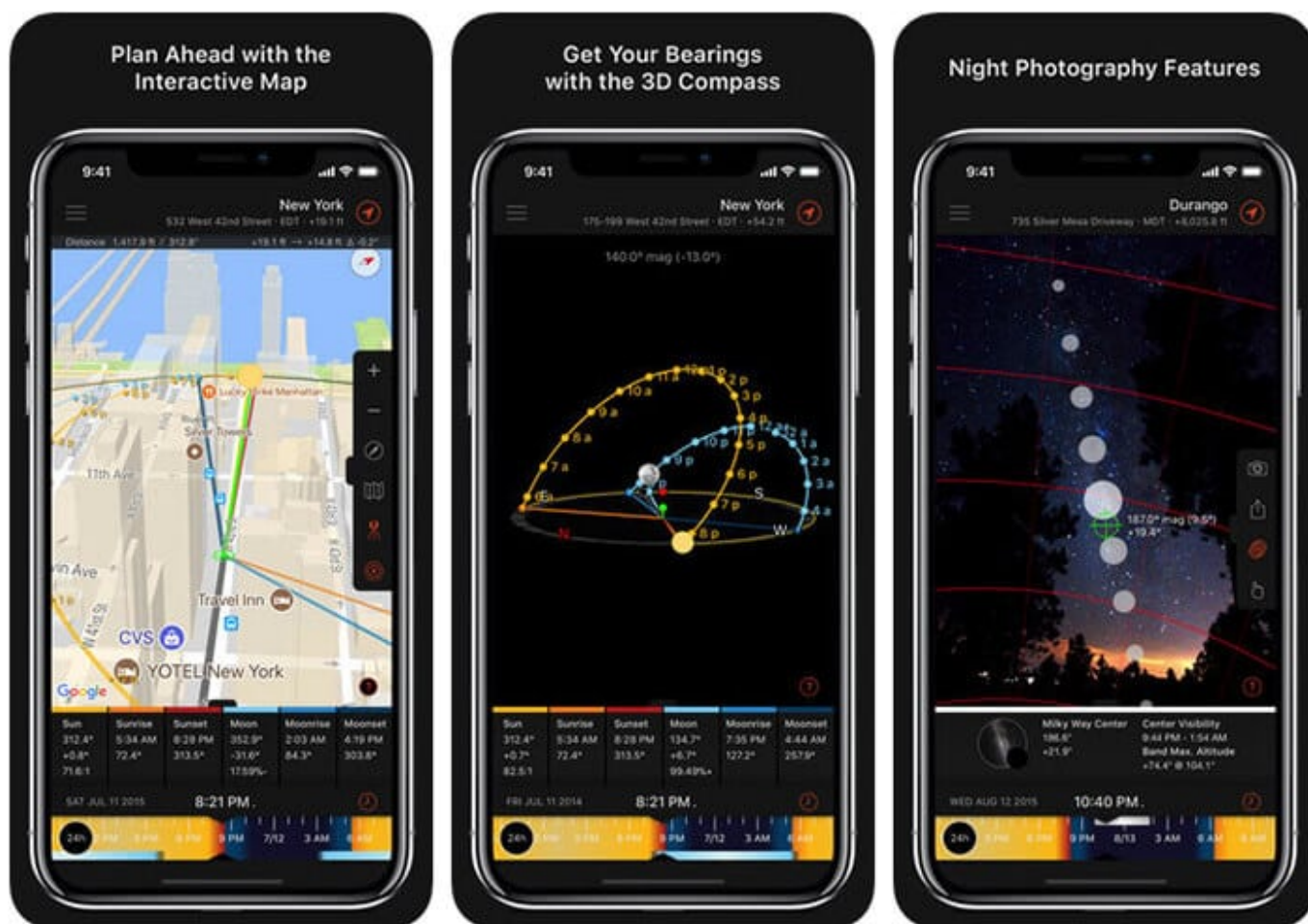

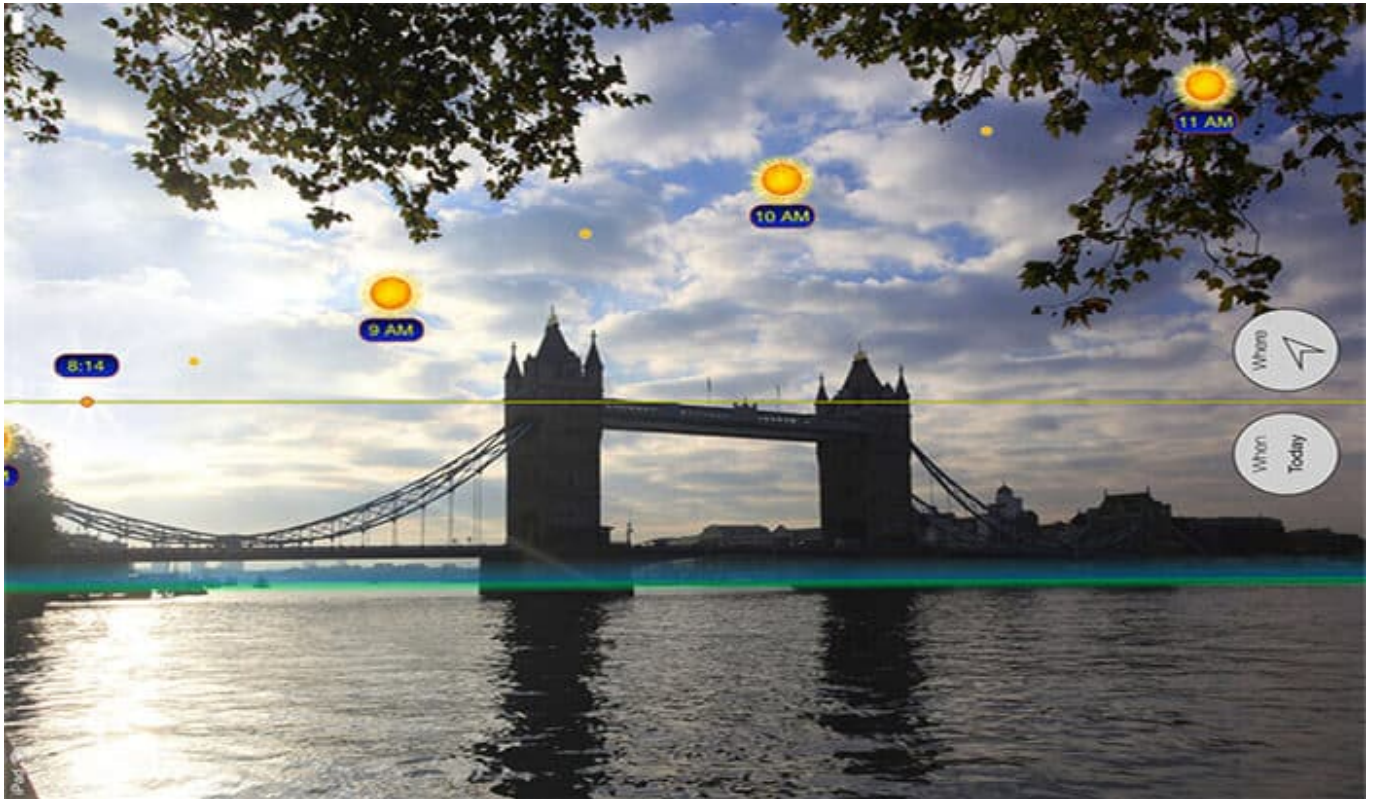
