Besides, it is suggested that before you delete your telegram account, you export your data. This is because once your account is deleted, there's no other way to access your Telegram contact lists, messages, groups, channels. Here's how you can do it.

Export your data from Telegram app to Mac

- 1. **Download** the <u>Telegram app for macOS</u> and **login** with your credentials.
- 2. Go to **Settings**.
- 3. Click Advanced settings.
- 4. Now select 'Export Telegram Data.'



5. Now, click **Export Chat History** and select the **data** you want to **export**.

Note: You can download data in JSON and HTML format.

How to delete your Telegram account permanently

You can choose to delete your telegram account either from iPhone/Android device or through a web URL. Let's know about both the ways individually.

By adjusting self-destruction settings on your iPhone

- 1. Open the **Telegram app** on your device and tap **Settings**.
- 2. Tap Privacy and Security followed by 'Delete My Account if I'm Away For.'
- 3. The shortest period mentioned is **one month**. Once you select that, your account will be automatically deleted if you **don't login** even once in the mentioned period.

Delete your Telegram account manually from the browser

- 1. Go to <u>Telegram Deactivation Page</u> and enter your registered **mobile number** with the country code.
- 2. Click next.
- 3. Enter the **confirmation code** sent to your registered number.
- 4. Click next.
- 5. Last, you'll be asked for the **reason** behind leaving. Click **Done** to proceed.

6. You'll be prompted to confirm through a popup window. Click **Yes, delete my account** to confirm.
