## How to use Apple Pay in-store

- 1. Open the **Wallet** app on your iPhone or Apple Watch, and then **select the card** you want to use for the payment.
- 2. Next, move your iPhone to **Target's terminal** or **NFC card reader**.
- 3. You will get a prompt to authenticate your payment with your Touch ID, Face ID, or

passcode.

4. Now, keep your iPhone or Apple Watch near the terminal, and your payment should read **Done**.

- 1. Head to the **Target web page** on the browser in the device you've set up your Apple Pay.
- 2. Find the item you want to buy on Target and click it
- 3. Next, select your options and click **Add to cart**.
- 4. Click View cart & checkout.
- 5. On your cart page, confirm the items you want to purchase and select **Continue** to checkout.
- 6. At checkout, select **Apple Pay** as your payment method.
- 7. Finally, authenticate your purchase with Face ID, Touch ID, or your device passcode.

- Third-party credit cards such as Visa, Mastercard, Discover/Novus, American Express,

credit cards from foreign banks and more.

- Debit/ATM and EBT cards
- Contactless pay using Target Mastercard or any other approved third-party credit card designed for contactless payment
- Gift Cards, including Target GiftCards, Merchandise Return Cards, and Prepaid Gift Cards with a Visa, Mastercard, Discover, or American Express logo
- Multiple payment methods sales
- Personal checks
- · Rebate checks
- WIC Program (in authorized stores only)
- Mobile Payments such as Apple Pay, Google Pay, Samsung Pay, or any contactless digital wallet
