
DoYourData Super Eraser offers several useful features as listed below:

The app is available for Mac as well as Windows system. To make the most of its handy features, <u>download and install DoYourData</u> on your Mac.

More overwrites reduce the possibility of extracting the deleted data from your computer, but it will also take longer to delete. For this review, *I left it at the default selection of one overwriting*.




Let's look at how you can use DoYourData for several tasks.


Use Super Eraser to delete files & folders

Note: You will not be able to recover files once they are deleted, so be 100% sure that you want to get rid of them permanently before following the steps below.


- 1. Open DoYourData and click **Erase Files and Folders** in the left-hand menu.
- Click Add and select the files or folders you want to delete permanently.
 To preview the files, you can click the magnifying glass icon on the right.



3. Then, select the ones you want to delete and click **Erase Now**.



4. In the confirmation dialog box, click **Continue**.



Use Super Eraser to wipe the hard drive

Note: This will wipe all data from your hard drive, and you will not be able to recover it. So proceed with caution.

- 1. Open DoYourData and select **Wipe Hard Drive** in the left-hand menu.
- 2. Select the disk you want to erase and click the **Wipe Now** button.



Use Super Eraser to wipe free space

This option is a safe way to wipe all traces of deleted data from your disk. It does not affect existing files but makes sure that files already deleted are not recoverable by any software,


- 1. Launch DoYourData and click **Wipe Free Space** in the left-hand menu.
- 2. Select the **disk** from which you want to get rid of all traces of deleted data.
- 3. Then, click **Wipe Now**.



Use Super Eraser for disk management

This feature lets you manage the internal and external disks on your Mac. You can rename, format, and eject them, respectively.


- 1. Go to DoYourData Super Eraser and click **Disk Manager** in the left-hand menu.
- 2. Select the disk you want to manage and then choose an option from those listed, such as **Rename** or **Format** for internal disks and **Eject** for external disks.



Use Super Eraser to uninstall apps

This function helps you offload any unused software from your hard disk, particularly any apps that are difficult to delete in any other way.

- 1. Launch DoYourData Super Eraser and select **Uninstaller** in the left-hand menu.
- 2. Select the apps you want to uninstall and click the **Uninstall** button securely.
- 3. Click **Uninstall** in the confirmation dialog box.




Use Super Eraser for browser cleanup


Over time, your browser accumulates many temporary files, cookies, and other junk that need to be cleaned to lighten the load and make it run efficiently. DoYourData makes it easy to clean up your browsers simultaneously.

- 1. Open DoYourData Super Eraser and select **Internet Cleanup** in the left-hand menu.
- 2. Click the **Scan** button.

You will need to close your browsers to continue with the process.



- 3. Once your browsers are closed, you will see an analysis of how much data can be cleaned.
- 4. **Select** the browsers and the data you want to get rid of, and then click **Clean**.

I deleted some sample files using the DoYourData Super Eraser and then tried recovering them using a few different data recovery tools. It was impossible to get back the deleted files. So, DoYourData does exactly what it is designed for and promises.
