Note: Switch doesn't transfer WhatsApp data. To transfer WhatsApp data from iOS to Android or vice versa, you can use their other tool called Restore Social App.

Transfer data from iOS to Android

This is one of the best features of this tool as most of the users find it extremely hard when switching from iOS to Android. With Switch from dr.fone, you can transfer 15 files types from iOS device to Android. That includes photos, videos, contacts, contact blacklist, messages, call history, bookmarks, calendar, voice memo, music, alarm records, voicemail, ringtones, wallpaper, and notes.

Transfer data from Android to iOS

If you are searching for something that seamlessly transfers your Android data to an iOS device, then Switch is the perfect solution. It supports nine file types from the abovementioned list. What it does not support is contact blacklist, ringtones, voicemail, alarm records, wallpaper, and notes.

Transfer data from iOS to iOS

Similar to transferring data from iOS to Android, iOS to iOS transfer also supports 15 file types. As it is the same ecosystem, there isn't anything special when transferring data between two iOS devices.

Transfer data from Android to Android

Switching between Android to Android is a piece of cake for people who have little technical knowledge. But it isn't straightforward for a newbie. With just one click on the Switch tool, you can transfer 11 File types from one Android device to another.

Let's see how it works.


How to Move Data from iPhone to Android and Vice-

Step #1. Connect two devices using USB to your PC or Mac.

Step #2. Launch dr.fone and click on Switch app.



Step #3. On the Switch app screen, one device will be detected as a **source** and other as a **destination**. You can flip the source and destination by clicking the **"Flip"** option on the screen.

Step #4. Once you are done selecting the device's status, use the checkbox beside different file types to make the selection. After everything's set up, all you need to do is to click the **"Start Transfer"** button.

You can also select **"Clear data before copy"** on the destination device. This will erase data from the destination device, and new data will transfer swiftly.
