## How to set up auto-reply for text messages on iPhone


The simplest and quickest way of setting up auto-reply text messages on iPhone is to customize the Driving Focus mode.


Follow the steps discussed below to enable this lifesaver hack on your iPhone.

- 1. Launch the **Settings app** on your iPhone.
- 2. Choose Focus.
- 3. Tap the (+) icon from the top-right corner.
- 4. Select the **Driving** mode.




- 5. Hit **Customize Focus** when prompted.
- 6. Now, select the **Auto-Reply** option.
- 7. Choose any one of the following AUTO-REPLY TO parameter
  - No One
  - Recents
  - Favorites
  - All Contacts
- 8. Finally, write an **auto-reply message** as you desire.

- 9. To further customize, head back to the main menu.
- 10. Scroll down and select the **While Driving** option.
- 11. Choose to ACTIVATE this mode **Automatically**.
- 12. You can also opt to enable **Activate With CarPlay**. *This will enable the Driving Focus mode when your iPhone is connected to CarPlay.*



From now on, whenever someone from the chosen category tries to contact you while CarPlay, Drive Focus, or both are on, they will receive a custom message notification.

**Pro Tip**: Don't go by its name. You can use Driving Focus mode any time you are busy or want to concentrate. To activate, access **Control Center**  $\rightarrow$  **Focus**  $\rightarrow$  **Driving**. Once the purpose is over, disable it the same way.

#### Modify or delete auto-reply in Driving Focus on iPhone

In case you decide to modify or deactivate Driving Focus mode, the process is simple.

#### To modify:

- 1. Simply navigate to **Settings** app  $\rightarrow$  **Focus**  $\rightarrow$  **Driving**.
- 2. Select the Auto-Reply option if you'd like to modify the Driving Focus mode.

#### To delete:

- 1. Go to **Settings** app  $\rightarrow$  **Focus**  $\rightarrow$  **Driving**.
- 2. Scroll to the bottom and tap **Delete Focus**.
- 3. Hit **Delete Focus** when prompted. *The Focus will be terminated promptly.*
