What is Instagram cache, and why should you clear it

on iPhone?

Instagram cache constitutes temporary files that improve its performance on the device, like speeding up load times. It can include cached info for accounts you visit often, search history, preloaded media for smoother playback, and more.

While useful, if you spend a lot of time on the app, this cache can pile up quickly and eventually fill your iPhone storage, leading to issues like:

- **Slow performance:** Your iPhone may start having issues such as lag due to limited space.
- **App crashes:** The app might freeze or close unexpectedly.
- **Limited file saving:** You'll have less space for photos, videos, and other files.

2 ways to clear Instagram cache on iPhone

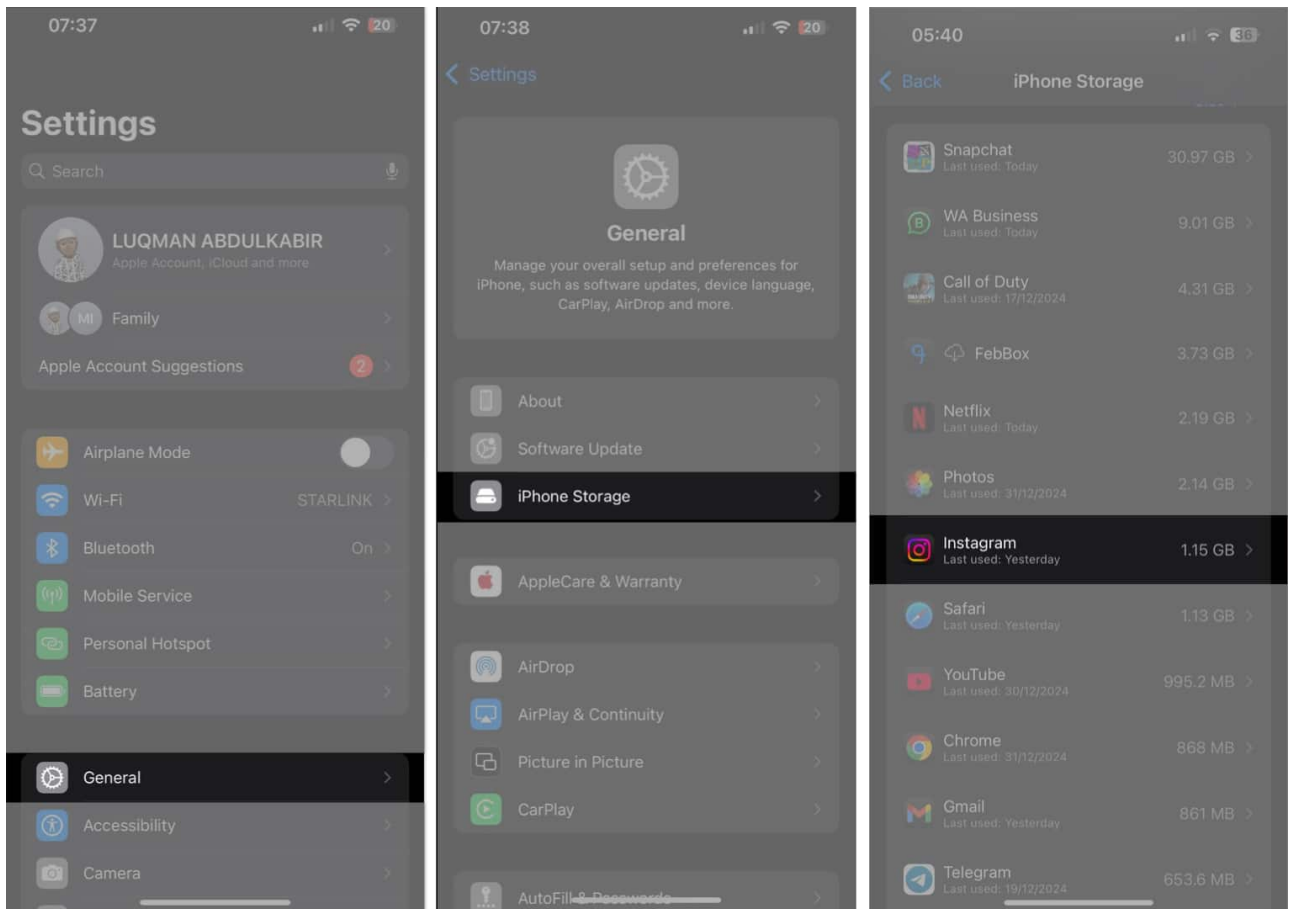
There are two simple ways to clear Instagram cache on your iPhone and free up storage from unnecessary data. Here's a step-by-step guide to help you do it easily.

1. Offload the Instagram app

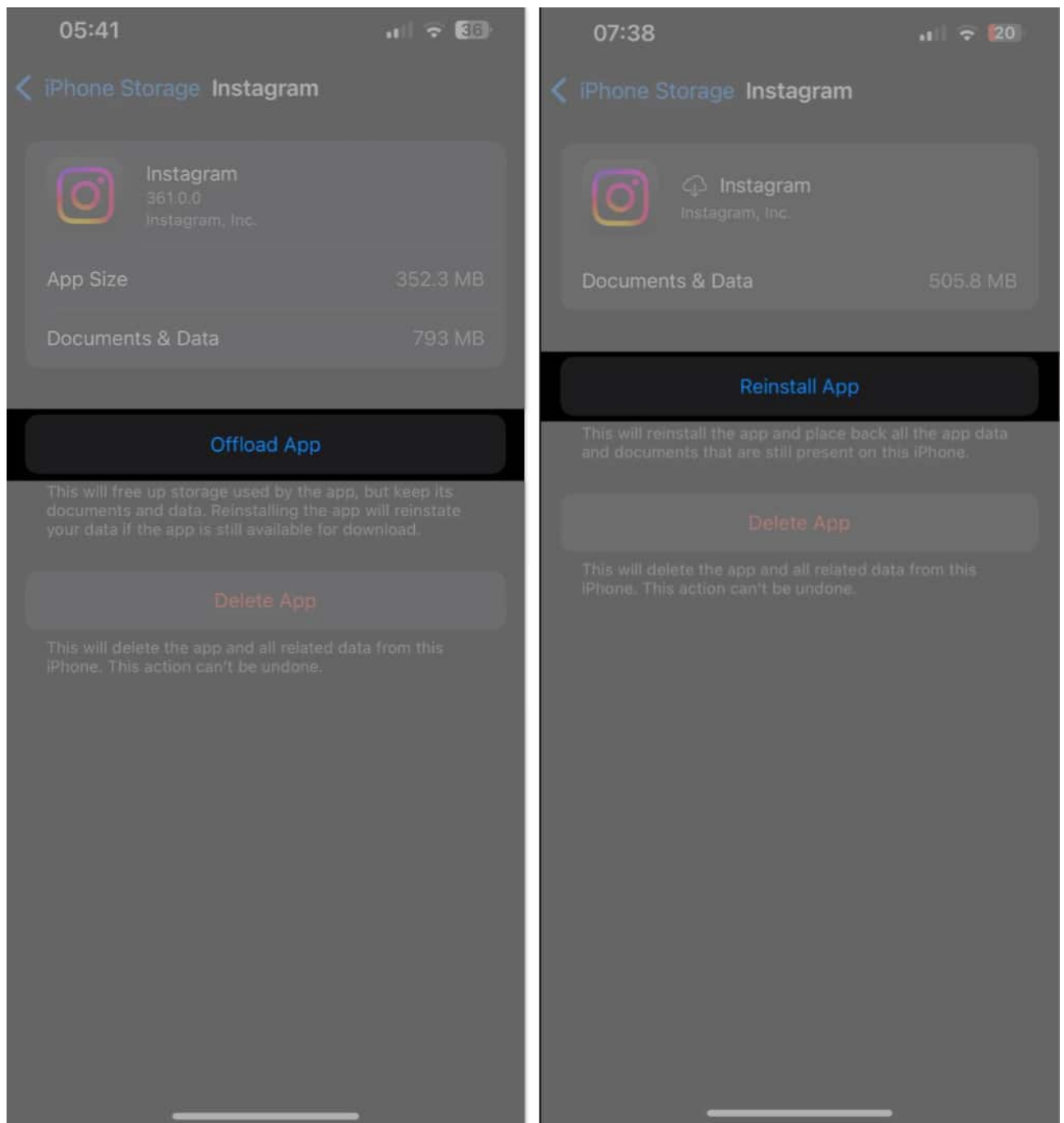
A straightforward way to clear Instagram's cache on your iPhone is to offload and reinstall the app. [Offloading an app on iPhones](#) implies removing the app from your device while keeping your account and app data intact. When you reinstall the offloaded app, the cache files are cleared, and the app starts building the cache from scratch.

Here's how to offload the Instagram app on your iPhone:

1. Open the **Settings** app on your iPhone.
2. Tap **General** and select **iPhone Storage**.
3. Find **Instagram** in the app list and tap it.



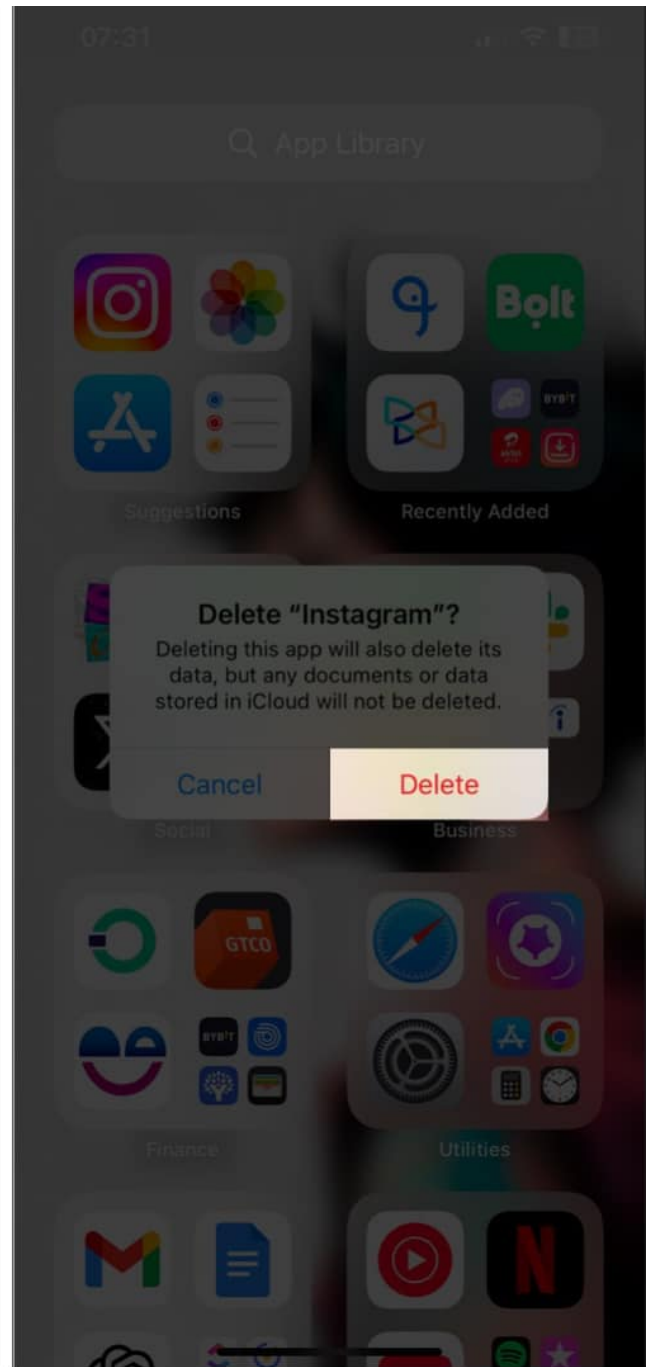
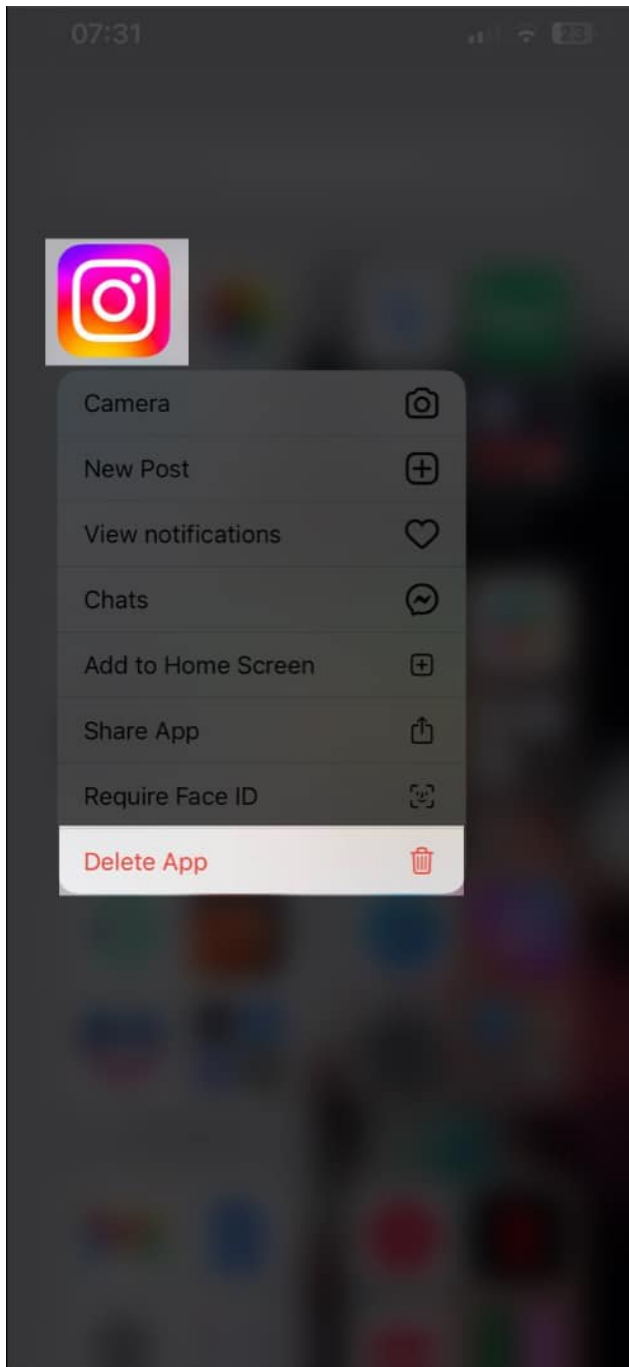
4. Tap **Offload App** and tap it again to confirm.
5. Once done, wait for a while, then tap **Reinstall App** to reinstall Instagram on your iPhone.



2. Clear cache by uninstalling Instagram

You can also clear Instagram's cache by deleting and reinstalling the app on your iPhone. It's best to take this approach when offloading the app doesn't help. Here's how to do it:

1. Find the **Instagram** app on your Home Screen or App Library.
2. Tap and hold the app, then select **Delete App**.
3. A confirmation pop-up will appear. Tap **Delete** to uninstall the app. This will remove the app and its data, including the cache.



4. Open the **App Store**, search for **Instagram**, tap the cloud icon, and follow the on-

screen prompts to reinstall the app. Sometimes, you may see the **Get** button instead of the cloud icon even if you installed the app on your device previously.

Note

Unlike offloading, you'll need to log in again after reinstalling, so keep your login credentials ready.

What happens when I clear the Instagram cache?

Clearing an app's cache, like Instagram's, removes temporary files and data, including thumbnails, images, videos, and search history. This helps [free up storage space](#) based on how much cache was taking up space.

However, as you keep [using Instagram on your iPhone](#), the app will start building new cache from your activities, like storing images, videos, and profile info. This adds to the accumulation over time.

To avoid a buildup of Instagram cache on your iPhone, you'll need to check and clear it regularly using one of the methods mentioned in this post.
