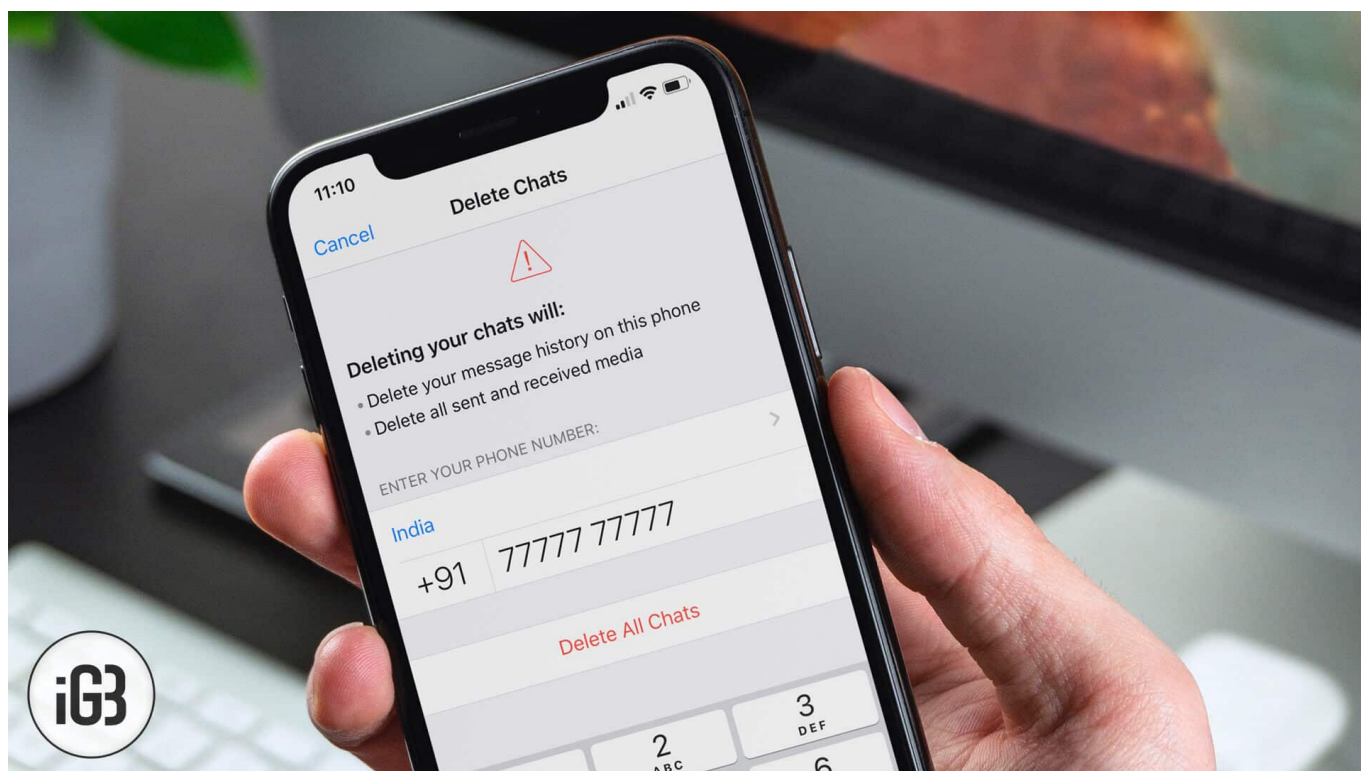

How to Delete Entire WhatsApp Message History on iPhone

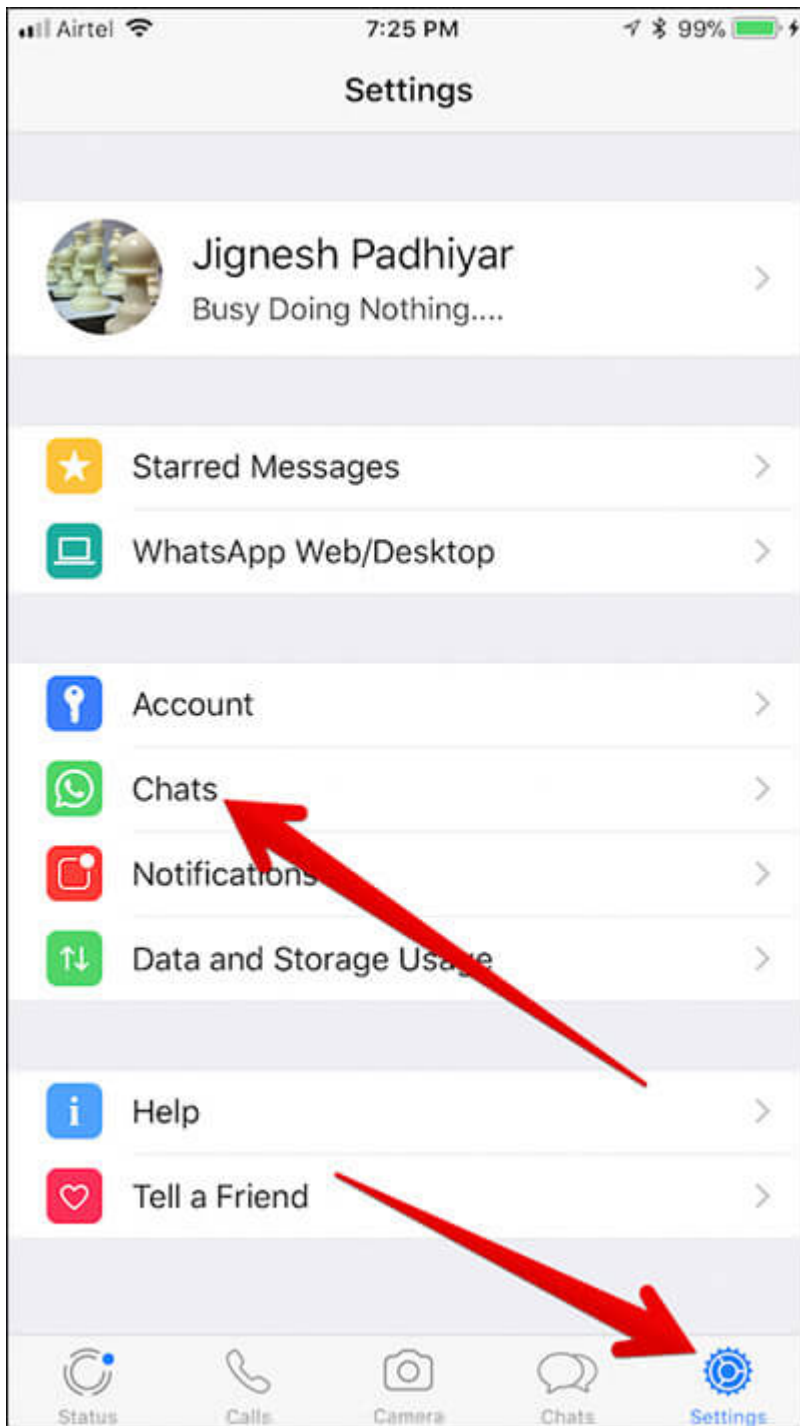
Because of certain reasons such as privacy you might want to clean up the entire WhatsApp message history including the sent and received media. Luckily, WhatsApp allows you to do it instantly.

There are a few things which you need to know before proceeding ahead:

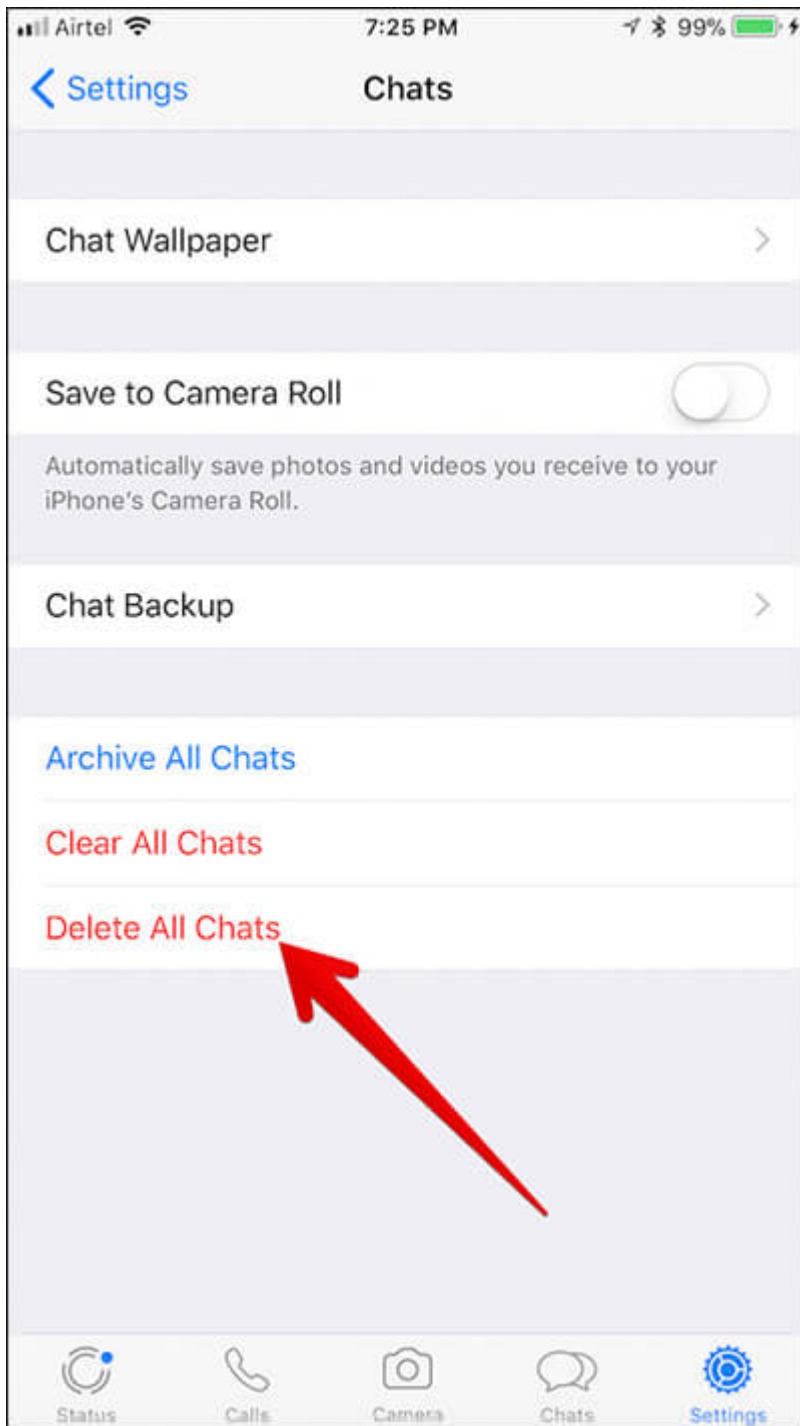
- It will delete the entire chat history-both individual and group
- It will also delete all the WhatsApp users associated with the individual chat
- It won't delete the name of Group chats. So, if you want to delete them, you will have to repeat the below-mentioned steps again

Step #1. Launch **WhatsApp** on your iPhone.

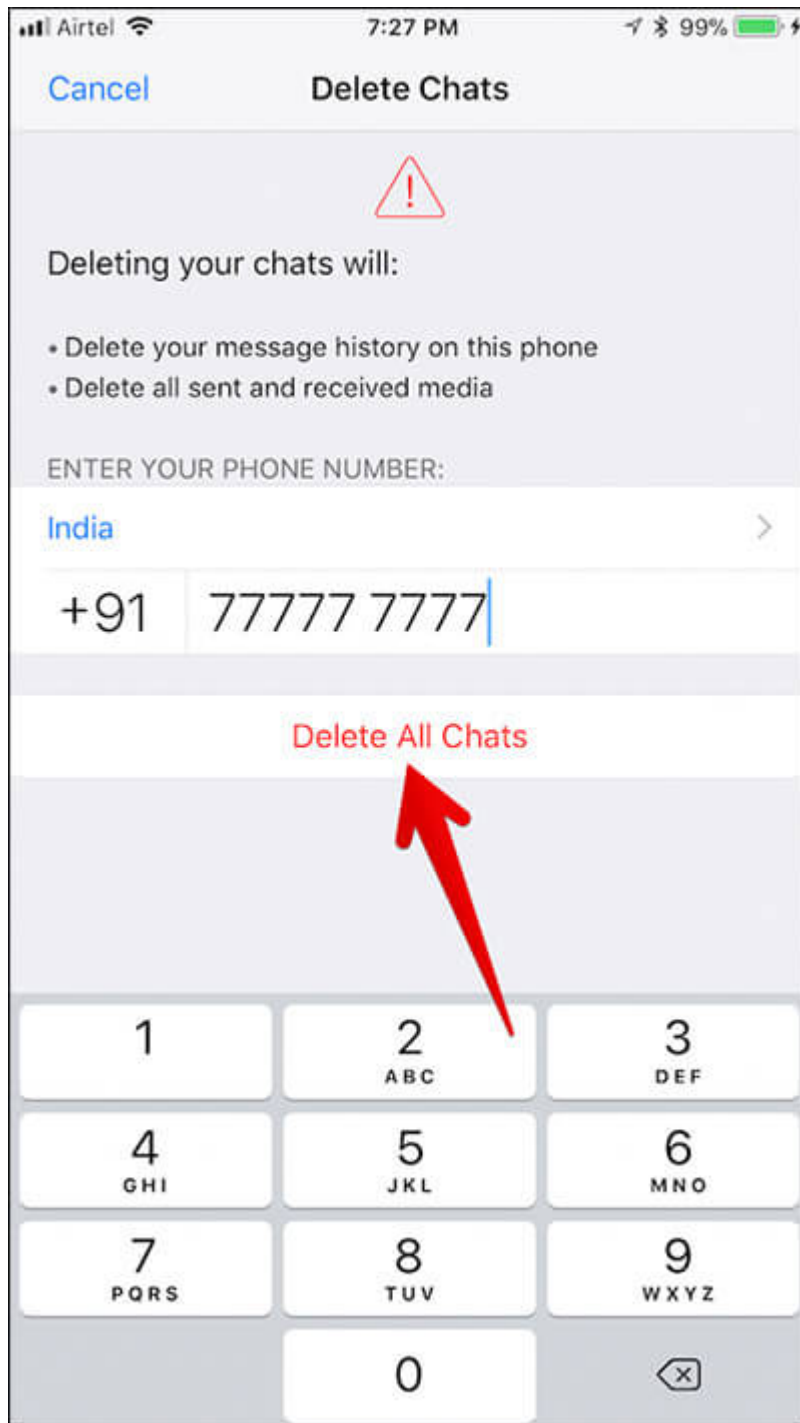
Step #2. Tap on **Settings** and then tap on **Chats**.



Step #3. Tap on **Delete All Chats**.



Step #4. Enter your **WhatsApp number** → Tap on **Delete All Chats**.



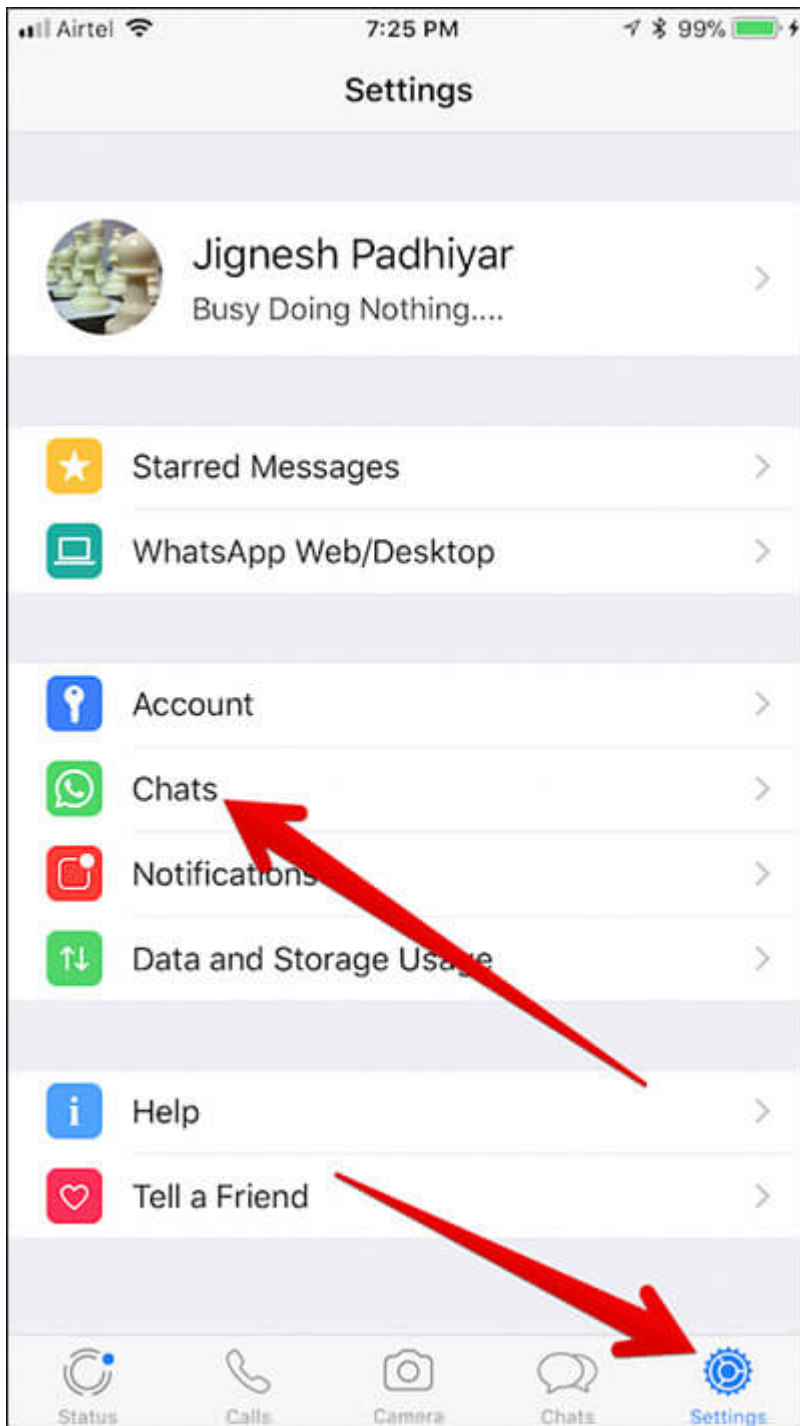
That's it!

As mentioned above, the Group chat names are still there. If you want to delete them all, go through the same steps again.

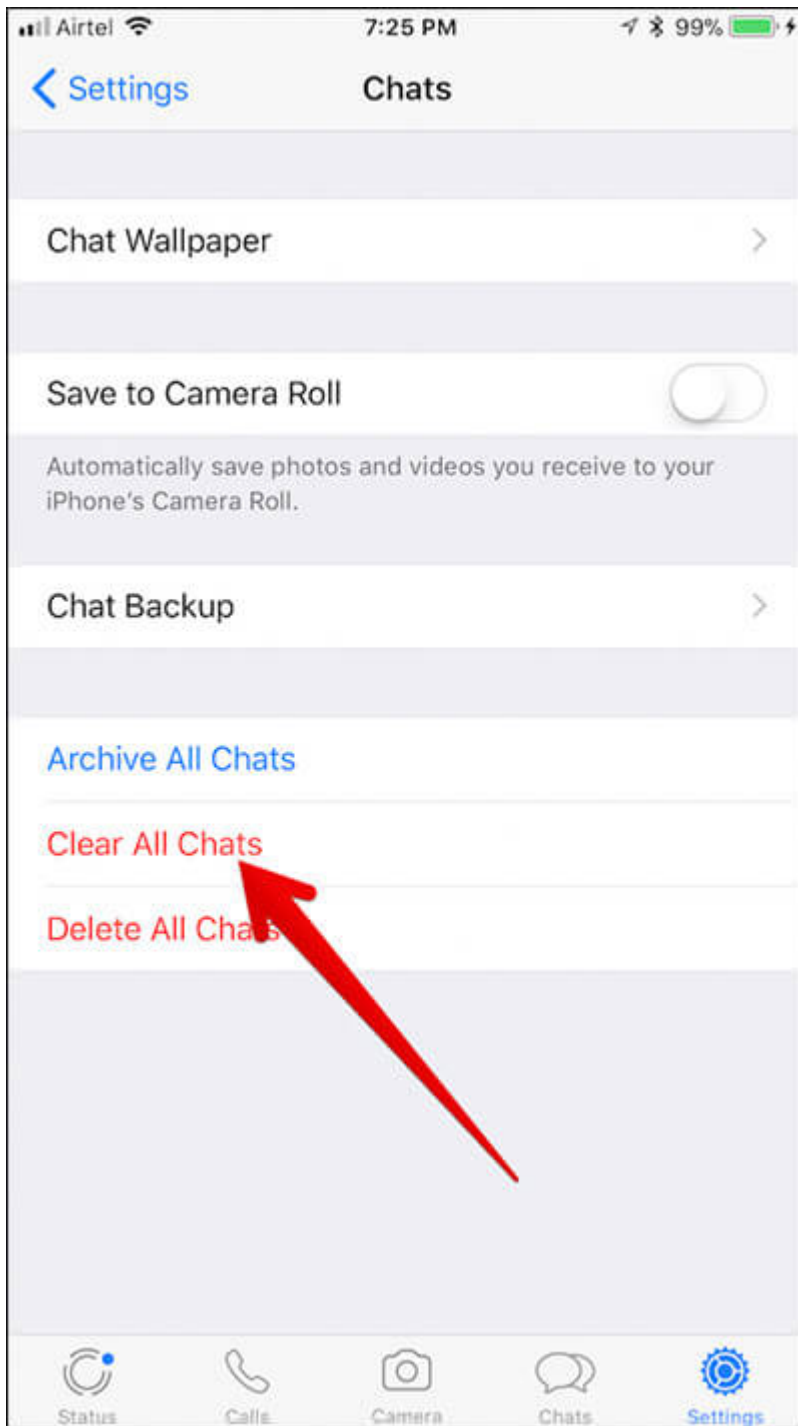
How to Clear All WhatsApp Chat history At Once on iPhone

Step #1. Launch **WhatsApp** on your iPhone.

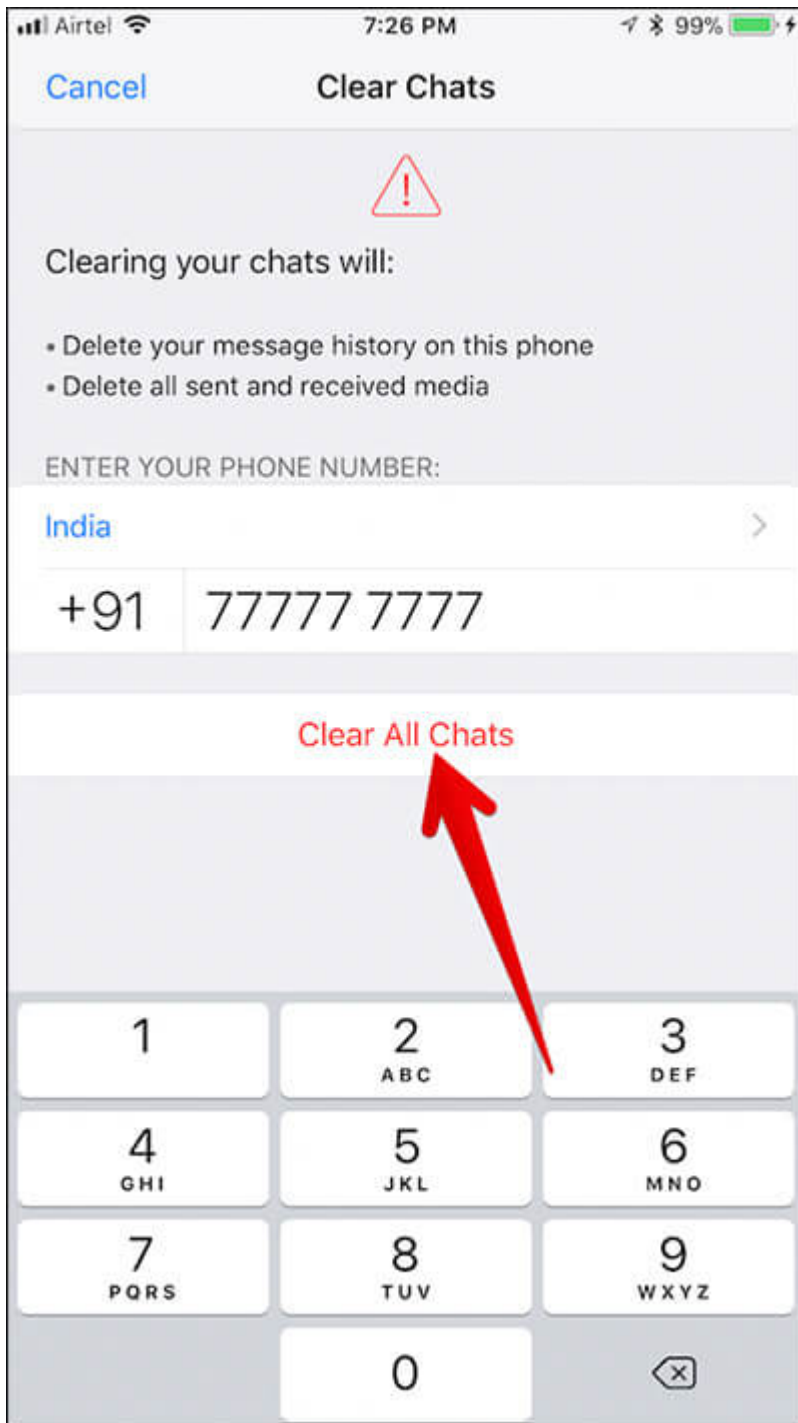
Step #2. Tap on **Settings** and then tap on **Chats**.



Step #3. Tap on **Clear All Chats.**



Step #4. Now, enter your **WhatsApp number** and then tap on **Clear all chats**.



All the chat history has been cleared off.

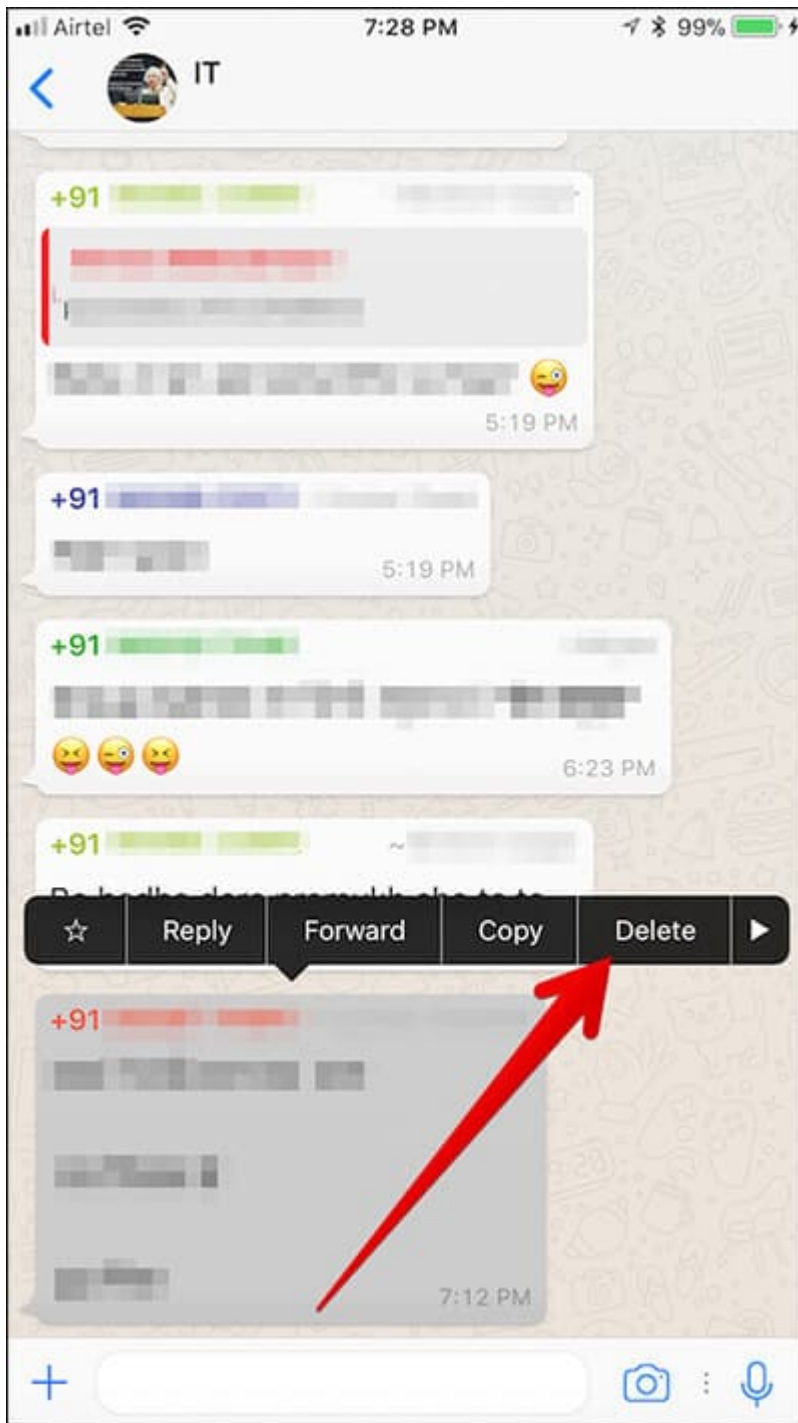
How to Delete Individual Message In WhatsApp

There are times; you would like to clear an individual chat history for privacy purpose. WhatsApp allows you to do it easily. Let's check out!

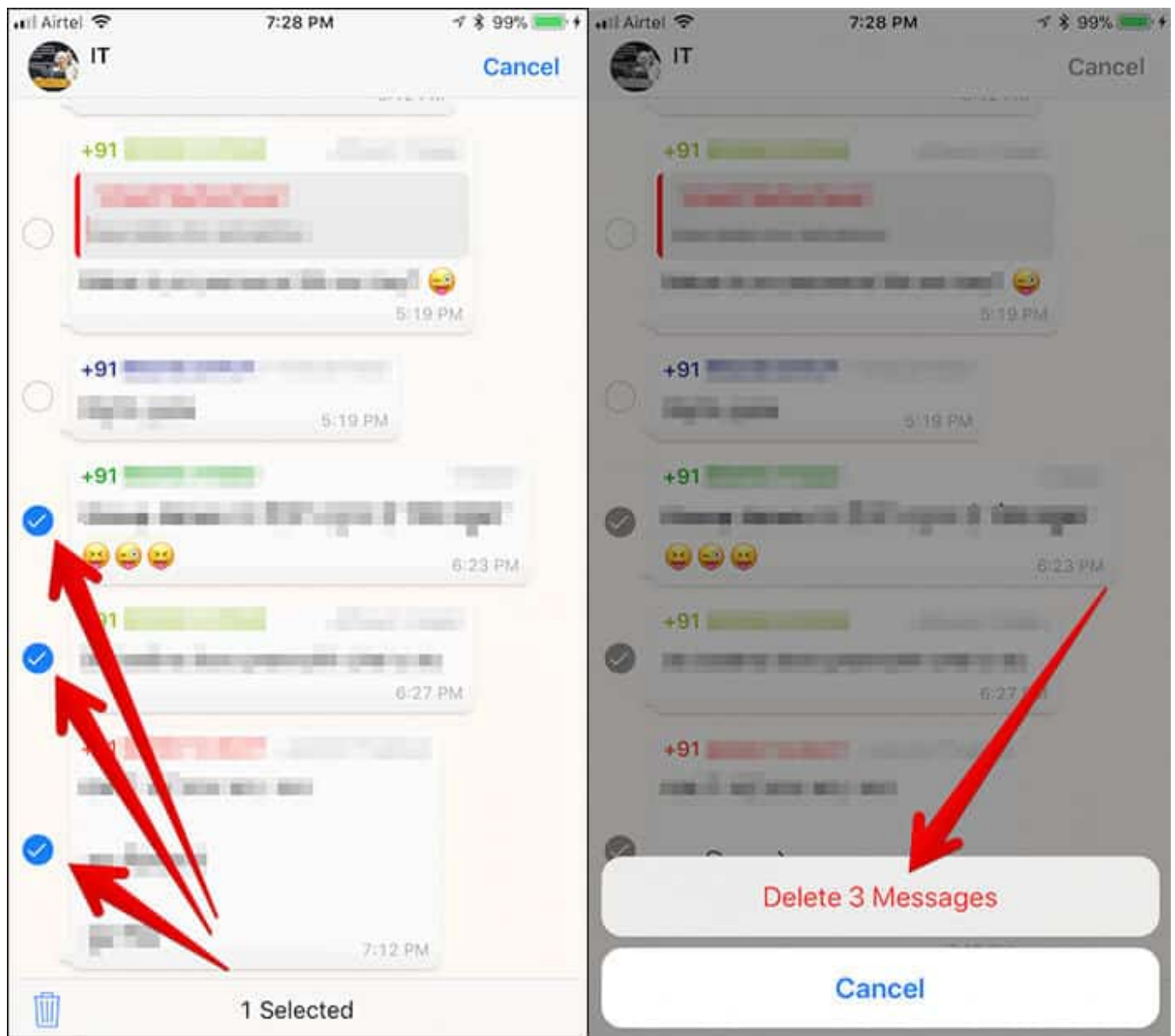
Step #1. Open **WhatsApp** on your iPhone.

Step #2. Next, make sure the **Chats** tab is selected at the bottom. Open the conversation which message you wish to delete.

Step #3. Now, you need to touch and hold on any message you want to delete. Then, tap on the **Delete button** in the popup window.



Step #4. If you want to delete multiple messages, tap on the **tiny circle** to the left of each message and then hit the delete button → Next up, tap on the recycle bin icon and **tap on delete message(s)**.

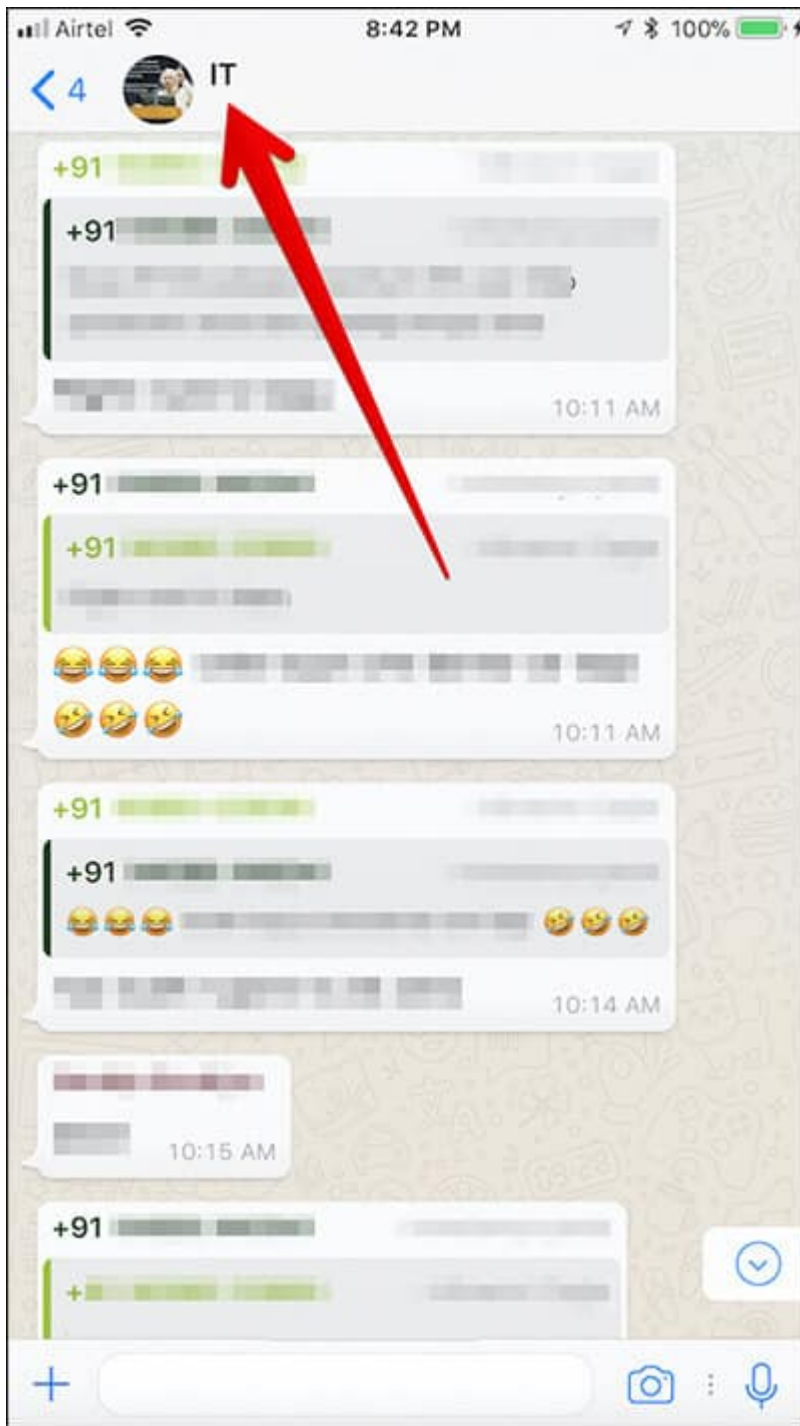


How to Delete Individual/Group Chat History In WhatsApp

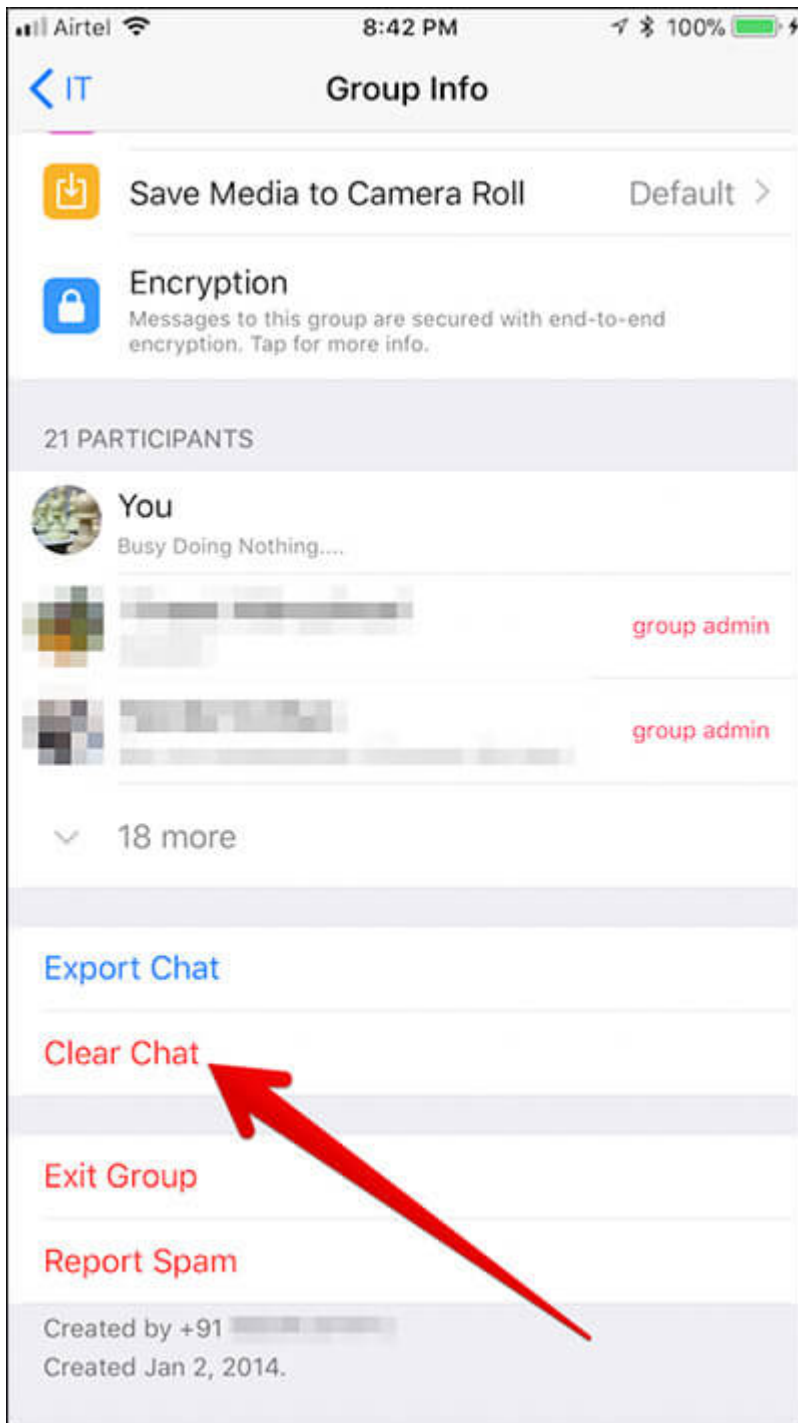
What if you want to delete an individual message in WhatsApp for any personal reason, how would remove it quickly. It's quite simple. Let's have a look!

Step #1. Launch **WhatsApp** on your iPhone → open the **conversation** which chats you want to clear off.

Step #2. Tap on the name of **individual/group name**.



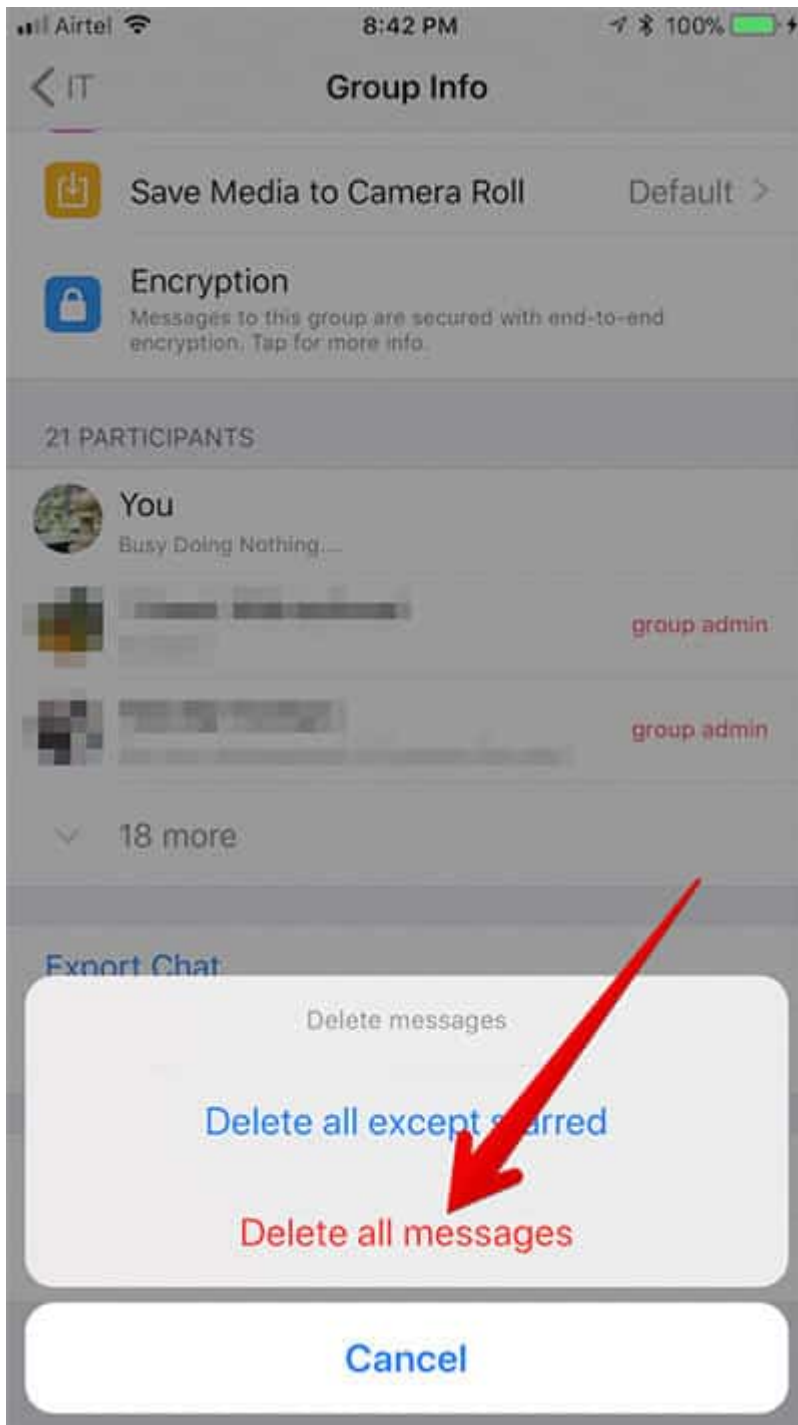
Step #3. Scroll down and tap on **Clear Chat**.



Step #4. Next, you have two options:

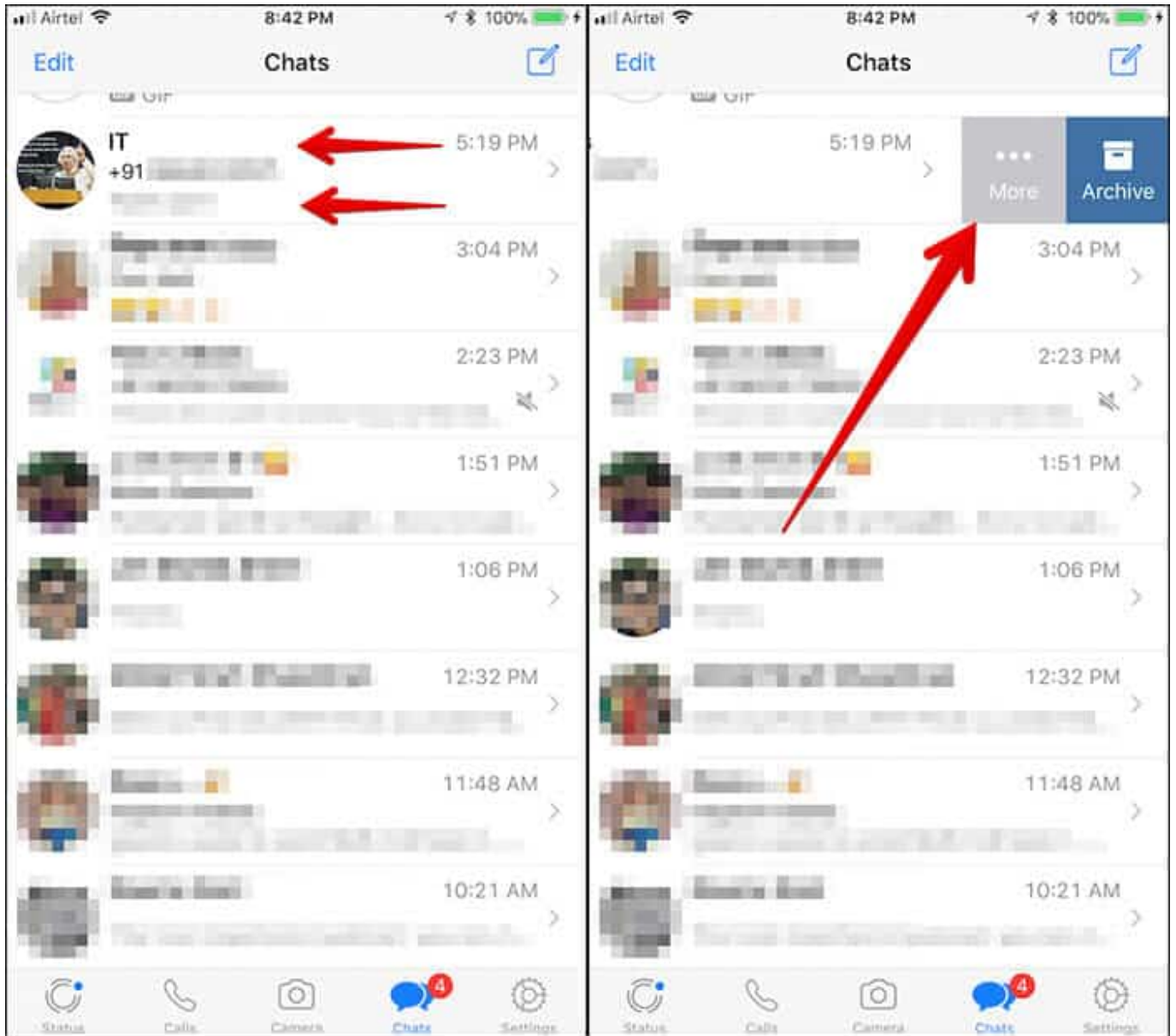
- Delete all except starred
- Delete all messages

Choose the preferred option.

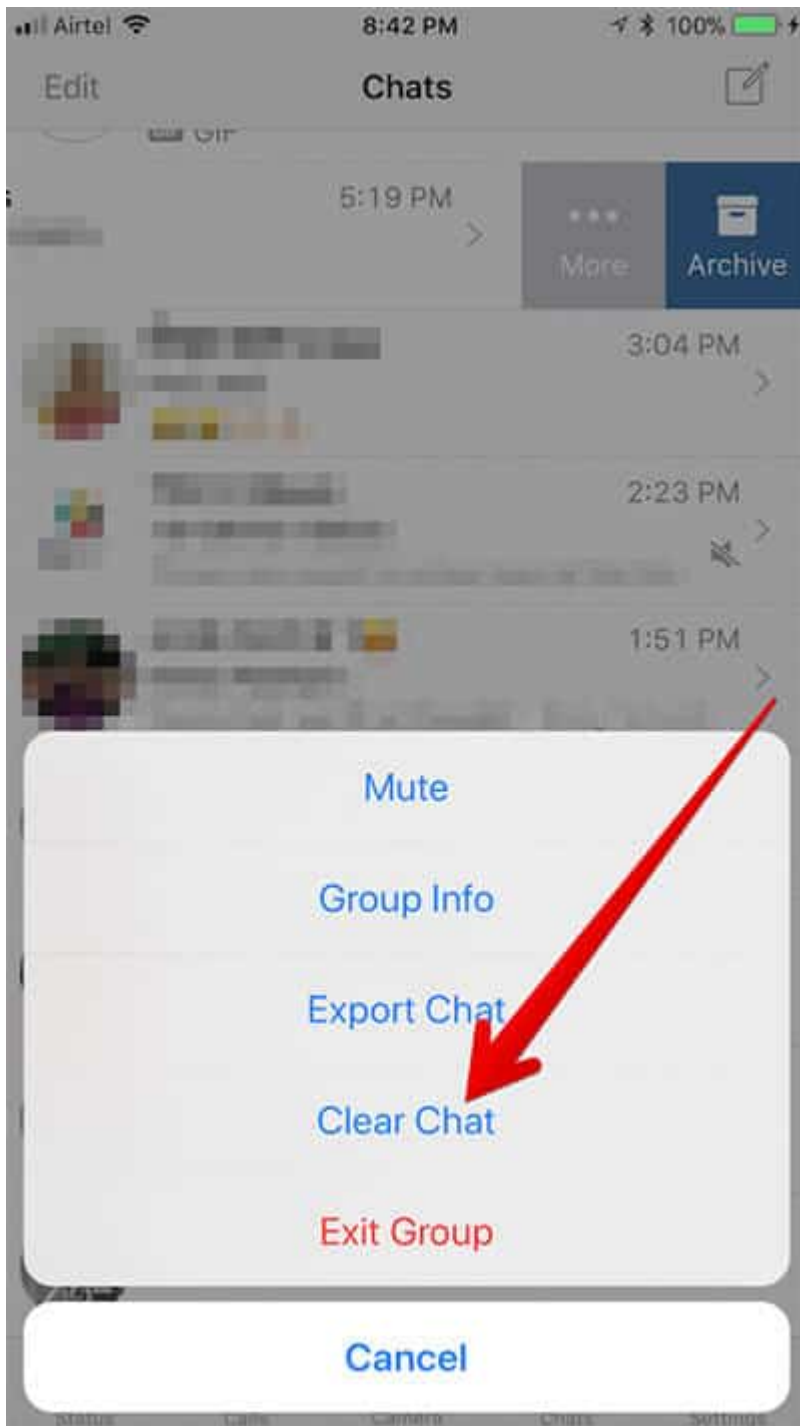


Alternatively,

Step #1. Swipe right to left on **Group/Contact name** → Tap on **More**.



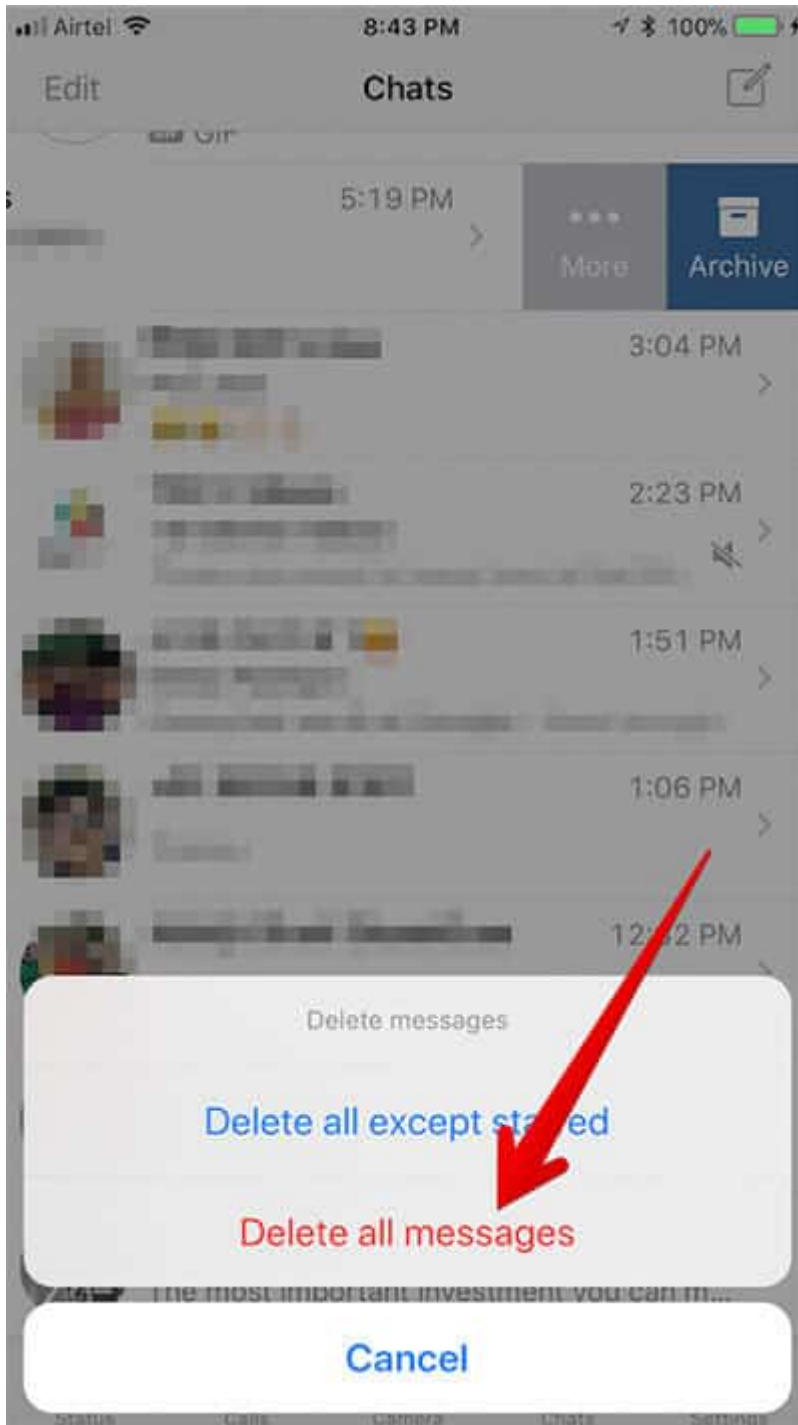
Step #2. Tap on **Clear Chat**.



Step #3. Now, you have two options:

- Delete all except starred
- Delete all messages

Choose the **preferred option**.
