

# How do you permanently delete WhatsApp account on iPhone

- 1. Open WhatsApp.
- 2. Tap **Settings** at the bottom right.
- 3. Go to **Account**.
- 4. Under Account, select **Delete Account**.
- 5. Now, enter your mobile number and tap **Delete My Account**.



After you follow the last step, your account will be deleted. Although the app will still be there on your iPhone, you will have to create a new account to use WhatsApp again.

# What happens when you delete your WhatsApp account?

- WhatsApp will delete all your chats, iCloud backup and remove you from groups.
- Your account info, including your profile photo and about section, will be deleted.
- Texts, media or documents, already sent will remain unaffected.
- You will no longer receive notifications from WhatsApp.

As is clear from the above consequences, deleting a WhatsApp account is the ultimate step, leading to the loss of data and information linked with WhatsApp. Hence, have a look at a couple of options below before deleting your account. One of them might work for you!

## Alternatives to deleting WhatsApp account on iPhone


You can try one of the following methods, which may prove to get your job done successfully instead of deleting the account.

### 1. Offload WhatsApp


This can be considered one of the best ways to get rid of WhatsApp if you decide to take a break but don't want your data and information to be deleted.

To offload the app, follow the steps below:

- 1. Open **Settings**.
- 2. Go to **General**.
- 3. Tap **iPhone Storage**.
- 4. Once you're in the iPhone Storage section, select **WhatsApp**.



- 5. Here, you'll see an option to **Offload App**.
- 6. Simply tap **Offload** App and confirm.



Following these steps will offload WhatsApp. This means the app will be removed, but all your data will stay safe on your iPhone. However, the app icon will still be visible on your Home Screen.

So, anytime you wish to start using WhatsApp again, tap its app icon. This will download the app, and you'll be good to go again without any loss of your data.

#### 2. Uninstall WhatsApp

Although this is not recommended, you can consider uninstalling the app if you simply want to take a break from it.

However, ensure to create an <u>iCloud backup</u>. This will keep your data safe. And, the next time you decide to install the app again, simply restore your data from the backup.

To uninstall WhatsApp, simply touch and hold the WhatsApp icon. Then, tap **Delete app** and confirm.

## Can my WhatsApp account be reactivated after deleting it?

A straightforward answer to this question is 'NO.'

Deleting a WhatsApp account is a one-way ticket. There's no such way of reactivating a deleted account. However, a new account can be created with a different number or even the same number on your iPhone.

- 1. To do that, <u>download</u> and open **WhatsApp** *If not uninstalled, simply open the app.*
- Now, follow the on-screen instructions.
  Note: Creating an account with the same number again won't restore your data as they're already deleted.

### **FAQs**

#### Q. Will deleting WhatsApp also delete data shared with Facebook and Instagram?

As per WhatsApp's policy, information shared with other Facebook Companies will also be deleted with the WhatsApp account.

#### Q. How long does it take for WhatsApp to delete your account permanently?

Deleting the account can take up to 90 days from the beginning of the process until the end.

### Q. Can I delete my old WhatsApp account after changing my number?

Changing the number automatically deletes your old WhatsApp account associated with the other number.
