

editor at a pretty low price, you've got to hurry up a bit!


How to Edit the PDF with PDFelement Express


Step #1. Launch <u>PDFelement Express</u> on your Mac.

Step #2. Now, import the file you wish to edit.

You can simply drag and drop the file in question into the program to get started with editing quickly.


Alternately, click on Open File button and then select the file you wish to edit. Once you have chosen the file, click on Open.





Edit Text


Next up, click on the **Edit button** on the left panel.




Up next, click on Select Mode at the top right and then choose Edit Text Mode in the menu. Now, go ahead and edit your text with ease.

Editing image is just as straightforward using this top-notch PDF editor. When you are in editing mode, click on Select Mode at the top right and choose Edit Image Mode.






Next up, edit the image to your best liking.


Edit Link

PDFelement Express lets you edit link as well. To do so, click on the **Edit button** on the left panel and then hit the Select mode at the top right. Next choose, Edit Link Mode. Now, edit, preview or delete the link.



Organize Pages in Sync with Your Workflow


The software lets you organize pages depending on your requirement. For example, you can rotate, insert, extract or even delete the unwanted pages without any hassle. To keep your pages in sync, click on the pages button on the left panel and then choose your preferred option.



How to Annotate PDF on Mac Using PDFelement Express

As for annotating PDF files, PDFelement Express is right on the money. What I like about this app is the neat user-interface. Everything looks quite familiar right from the moment you dive into it.


- **Step #1.** Open **PDFelement Express** on your Mac.
- **Step #2.** Now, **drag and drop the file** into the app. Then, click on the **Edit** button on the left panel.
- Step #3. Next, click on the Comments button.




Then, you have the option to add comments with highlights and sticky notes.

And I'm really glad that the app has got plenty of options from adding a signature, sticky note, text comment to sketching your imagination to perfection, it has got several tools to ensure you don't run out of options.





When it comes to annotation, you should always be ready to give several concepts a shot to have a surprising result. To ensure, you can always go back and forth; the app offers to undo and redo buttons. So, even if something goes wrong, you will have the option to undo it without any problem.

PDFelement Express is designed for the folks who want to have a pretty simple yet highly functional PDF editor. With the wide range of editing tools and clean interface, the software ensures your time with editing remains smooth-sailing.
