


Once you find the apps that enjoy access to the microphone, you can toggle it off or keep it toggled on.

How to Prevent Apps from Accessing Your Microphone on iPhone or iPad


Step #1. Launch **Settings** app → Tap on **Privacy**.



Step #2. Tap on **Microphone**.



Step #3. Now, one by one **turn off** the switch next to each app.



These apps can use the Microphone app as they have features that require a microphone. For example, you can leave a voice message via WhatsApp, and hence, you need to integrate the Microphone with WhatsApp. You can toggle the switches of the apps to control them.

To fully use the app, you usually need to toggle the switches ON to use the microphone. However, for security reasons, you can toggle the switch OFF if you don't use the microphone.
