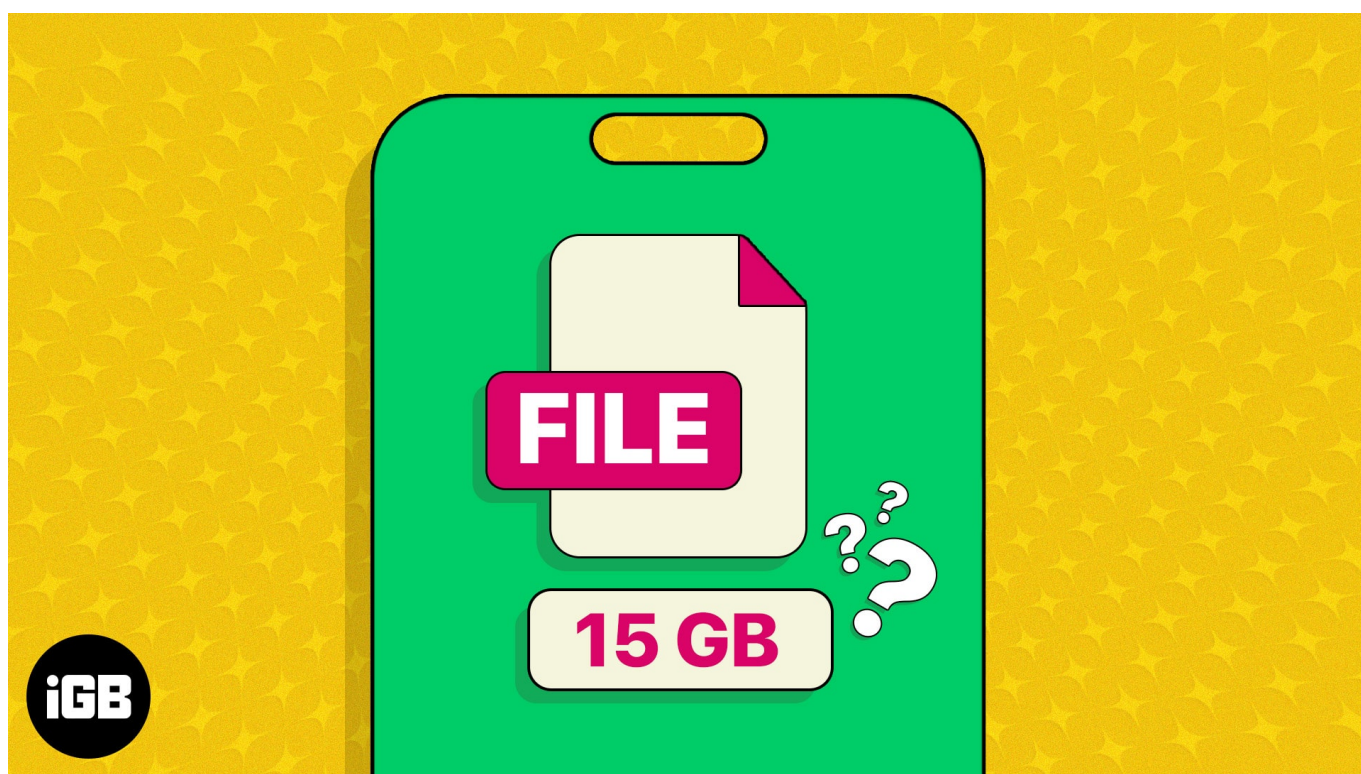


Summary

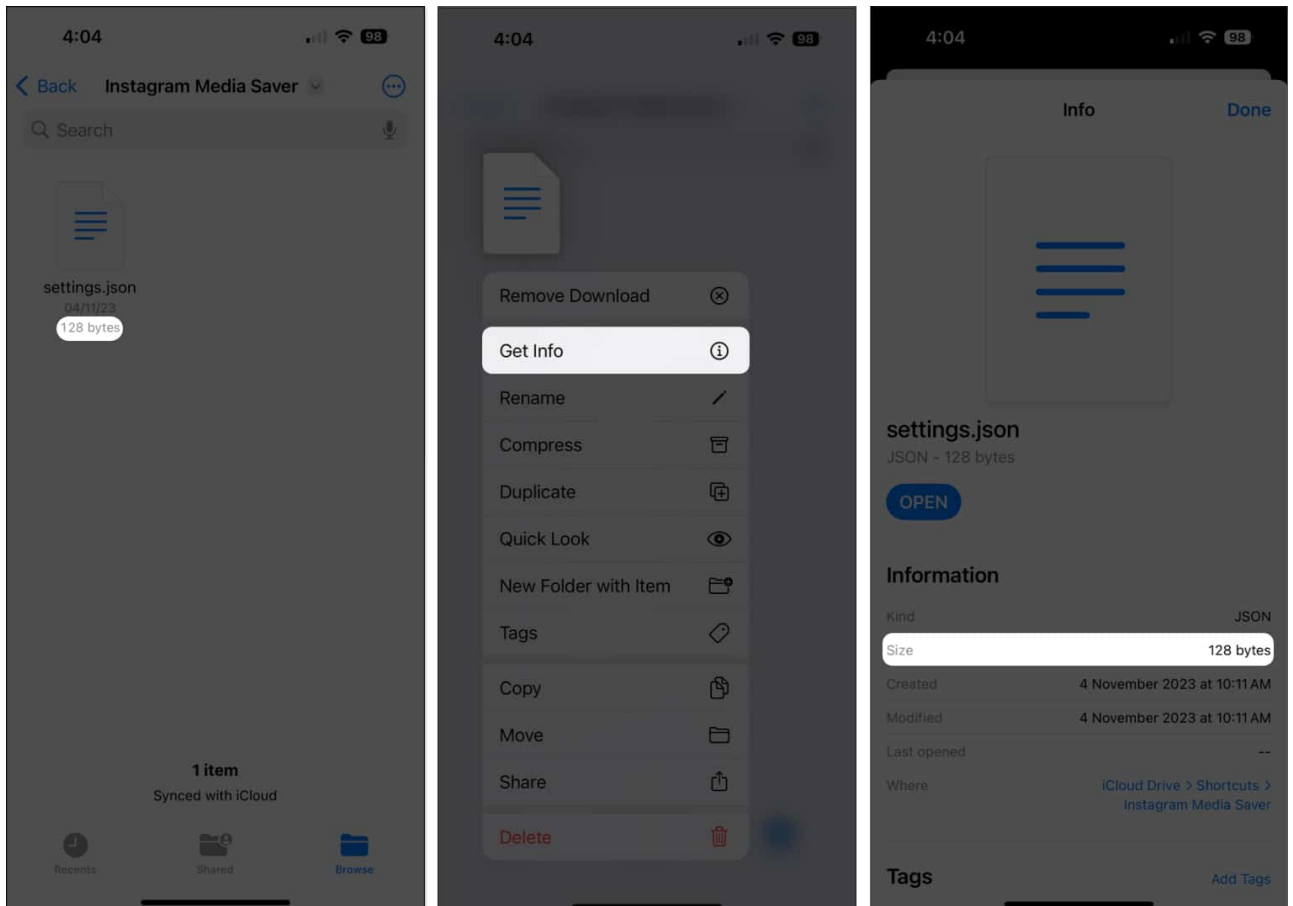

3. If the size is not visible, press and hold the **file**.

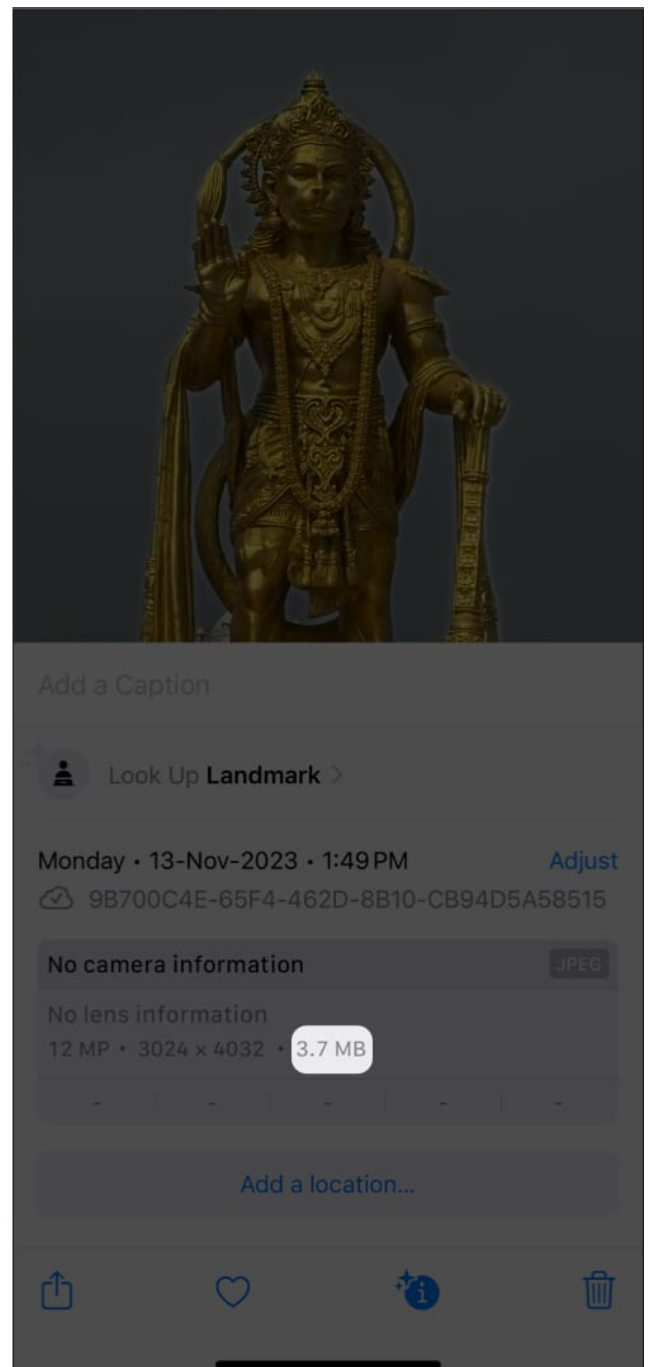
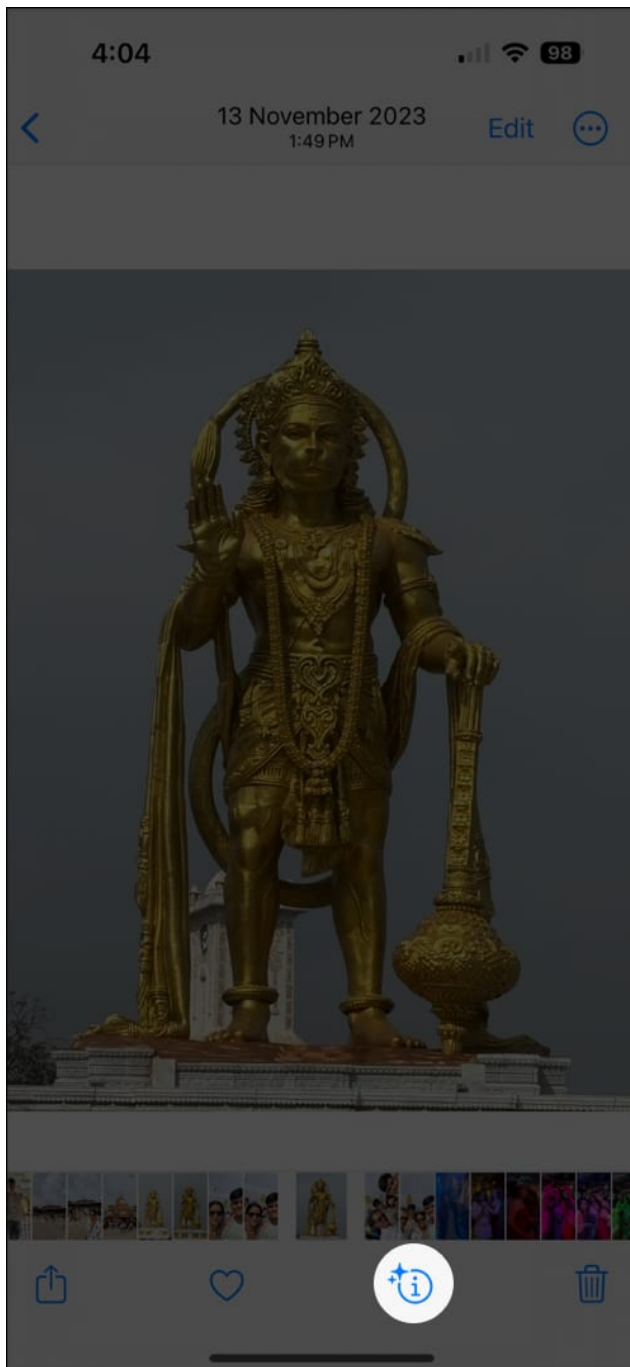
4. Select **Get Info** from the pop-up menu.
