2. Downgrade your device to stable iOS

If you don't want to go through the rigor of copy-pasting, then it's time to go back in time. Even if the beta versions of iOS enrich the users with exclusive new features, it's prone to bugs and errors. Exhibit 1: Threads.

The issue might seem irreversible at first, but there's a fix. You can <u>downgrade your iPhone</u> <u>running iOS 17 beta</u> to the last stable operating system. This will make the Threads app compatible with your iPhone.

3. Other possible fixes

The solutions prescribed above will mostly get you going with the Threads app. However, there are a few other factions you can tend to if the problem still persists.

- Force Quit: Access the Threads app and force quit the app before taking any extreme actions.
- Ensure that the Threads app has access to a **reliable internet connection**, be it through Wi-Fi or cellular networks.
