On iOS 14 and later, your favorite smart assistant Siri appears as a small circle at the bottom of the screen when invoked. But you can make Siri full-screen on your iPhone if you want. This was the norm on earlier versions of iOS. If you prefer the older full-screen interface, here's how to get it on the latest iOS versions too.



How to enable full-screen Siri on iPhone

- 1. Open the **Settings** app.
- 2. Tap on **Accessibility**.
- 3. Tap on **Siri**.

4. Disable Show Apps Behind Siri.
