What is Apple Music Replay?

Apple Music Replay is a feature that gives you insights into your listening habits so you can

know more about your musical preferences. It's available as a monthly replay as well as a year-end replay.

With the Apple Music Replay 2024, you get a detailed summary of listening habits from January 2024 to December 2024. This includes the total number of minutes you streamed music on the platform from various artists across different genres.

Additionally, you can see if you are given the title of a superfan of a particular artist. You also get a comparison of your top artists of 2023 with 2024, so you can understand how your stats and listening habits have changed within a year.

How to get Apple Music Replay 2024

While earlier, the yearly Apple Music Replay could only be reviewed via the Apple Music website, things have changed with iOS 18.1. If you own an iPhone running on iOS 18.1, you can head straight to the Music app and get your Apple Music Replay 2024 on the **Home**, **New**, and **Search** tabs.

On the other hand, if you have an iPhone running on a lower iOS version or using the streaming service on an iPad, Mac, Android, or the web, you can continue to access your Apple Music Replay 2024 highlight reel via the website.

On iPhone running on iOS 18.1

- 1. Open the **Music** app and ensure you are on the **Home** tab.
- 2. Scroll down and tap on Replay: Your Top Songs by Year.
- 3. Tap the **Play** button.



On iPad, Android, Mac, or PC:

- 1. Go to the <u>Apple Music Replay website</u> and sign in with your Apple ID.
- 2. You will now see the **Replay** banner on the **Home** page with the **Jump In** button. Hit it.
- 3. As the next page loads, hit the **Play Highlight Reel** button to play the reel. Or scroll down the page to find your Apple Music Replay 2024 statistics.

Stats you can view in your Apple Music Replay

Apple creates your Apple Music Replay using your monthly listening insights on the platform. Here's everything you can review and do in your Apple Music Replay:

• **Monthly insights:** Once you have listened to enough music on the platform, Apple gives you insights into the top songs, artists, and albums you have listened to each month. These monthly insights are calculated using the play count and time spent

listening to a particular artist or song.

- **Year-end replay:** At the beginning of December every calendar year, you can view the top songs, artists, and albums you have listened to throughout the year. This yearly insight is built using all your monthly insights for the said year.
- **Play your ear-end highlight reel:** View an audio and visual recap compilation of the music you listened to the most throughout the year.
- **Top listeners:** You also get to know whether you are among the top 100, 500, or 1000 listeners for any particular song, artist, or genre.
- **Share insights:** You can easily share your personalized yearly or monthly music listening insights with your friends and family via social media or messaging apps.

Share your Apple Music Replay playlist

If you want to share your Apple Music Replay playlist with friends or family, you can do so like this:

- 1. Open the **Music** app and scroll down to the **Replay: Your Top Songs by Year** section.
- 2. Here, tap and hold the **Replay'24 tile**, then select the **Share Playlist** button in the contextual menu that appears.

3. Finally, select the app using which you want to share your Replay'24 playlist from the Share Sheet and choose the contact.

Can't see your Apple Music Replay 2024? Try this

There can be only two major reasons why you can't see your Apple Music Replay 2024: either you haven't streamed enough music on the Apple Music app or have probably tuned off your listening history by mistake.

If the first reason holds for you, you will see a **Keep Listening to Apple Music** button on the Replay'24 screen instead of the yearly stats. However, if you are sure that you have listened to enough music on the Apple Music app, you must check whether the listening history for the Music app is turned off. Here's how:

- 1. Open the **Settings** app on your iPhone, scroll down to the bottom, and tap **Apps**.
- 2. Locate and tap on **Music**.
- 3. Scroll down and check whether the Use Listening History toggle is on. If not, turn it

on.



On a Mac:

- 1. Open the **Music** app.
- 2. Click **Music** in the top menu bar and select **Settings**.
- 3. Go to **General** and make sure the **Use Listening History** checkbox is ticked.

On Android:

- 1. Open the **Apple Music** app.
- 2. Tap the three-dot button in the top-right corner and select **Settings**.
- 3. Finally, toggle on the switch for **Use Listening History**.

Once done, your Apple Music listening history will then reflect on the Apple Music Replay 2024.
