


How to sync Google Calendar with iPhone Calendar app

1. Open the Settings app, tap on Mail. Now tap on Accounts.




2. Tap on Add Account and select Google.

- 4. Turn the **toggle on** for **Google Calendars** in the new window and tap on **Save.** The calendars will take some time to sync.



- 5. Now open the **Calendar app** and tap on **Calendars** located at the bottom of the page to view all the calendars linked with your Gmail account.
- 6. Now select the **calendars** you want to have in your iOS Calendar app and tap on **Done.**

Can you sync multiple Google accounts with iPhone Calendar?



How to sync other people's Google Calendars to your iPhone


- 1. To begin with, you'll need the ICAL link of the calendar you want to sync. Keep it handy.
