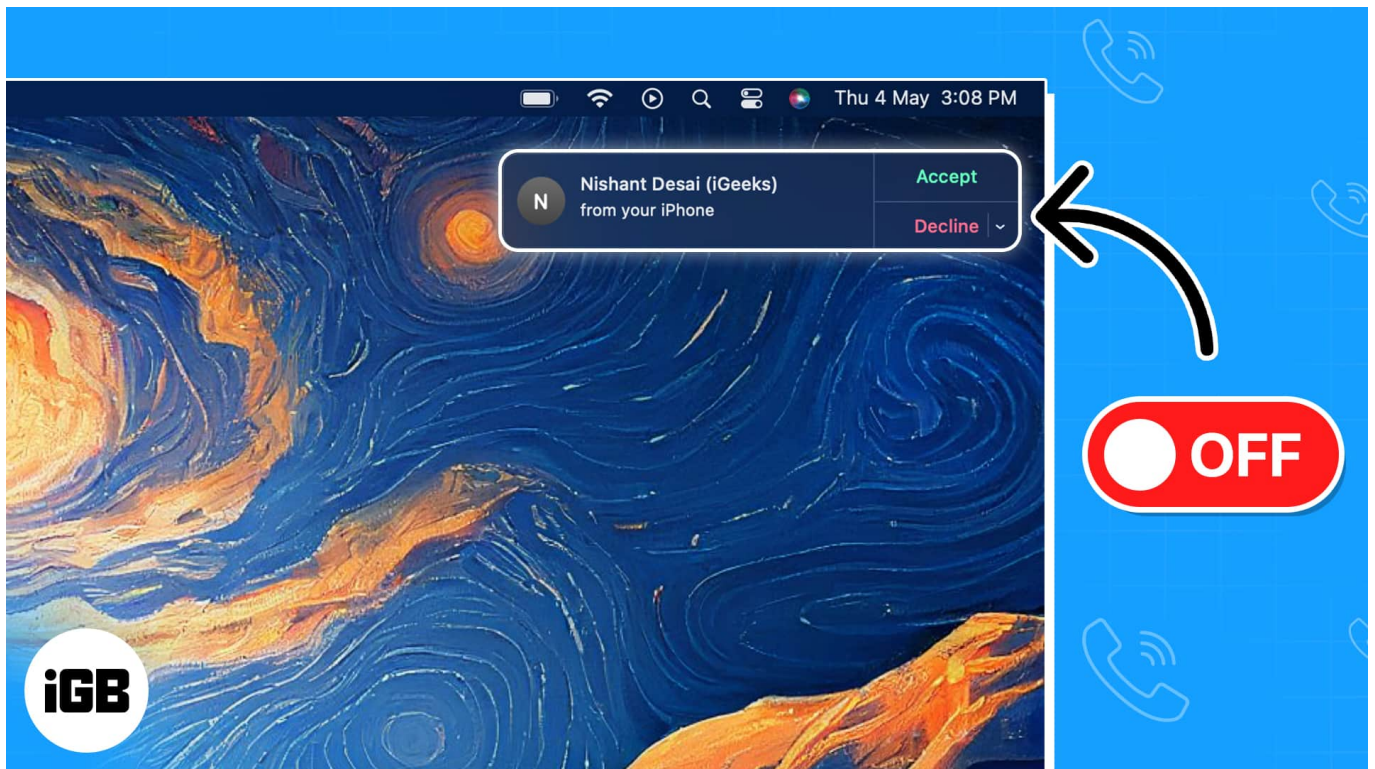


I adore how easy it is to make and receive phone calls from my iPhone when I'm working on my Mac. However, there are times when I want to be free from interruptions to focus solely on my work.

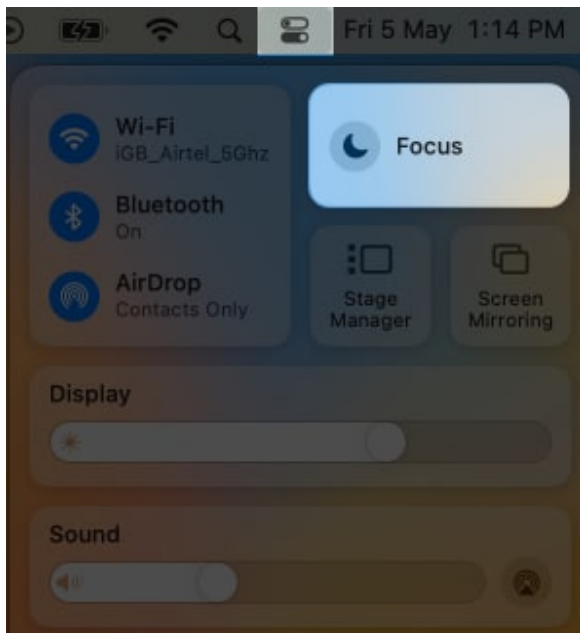


If you're somewhat like me, you're in luck because, in this article, I'm about to tell you how to turn off phone calls on Mac, both temporarily and permanently.

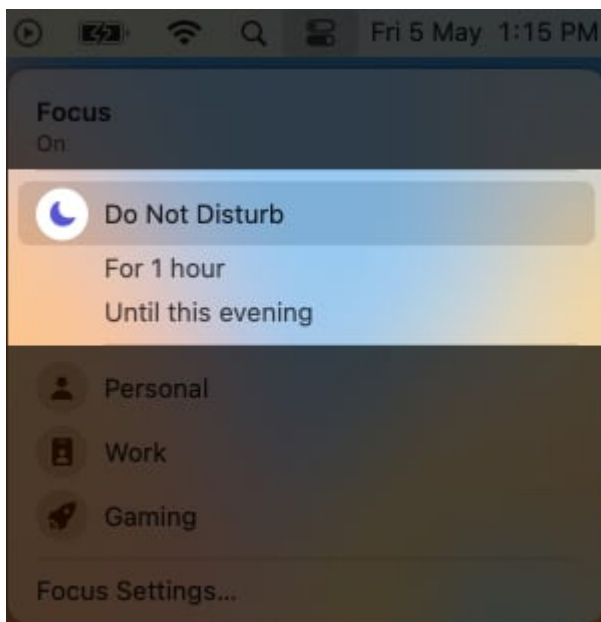

How to temporarily turn off phone calls on Mac

1. Click the **Control Center** icon in the Mac menu bar → Select **Focus** from the list.



2. Choose **Do Not Disturb**.

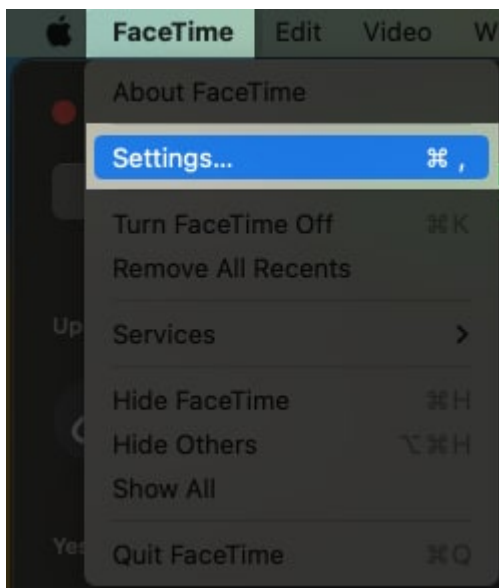
Using Siri

1. Invoke **Siri** from the Launchpad. You can also say “**Hey Siri**” if you’ve set it up.
2. Once Siri is listening, give the command, “**Turn on Do Not Disturb until this evening on my Mac.**”
3. Now, **Siri** will confirm that the feature has been turned on.

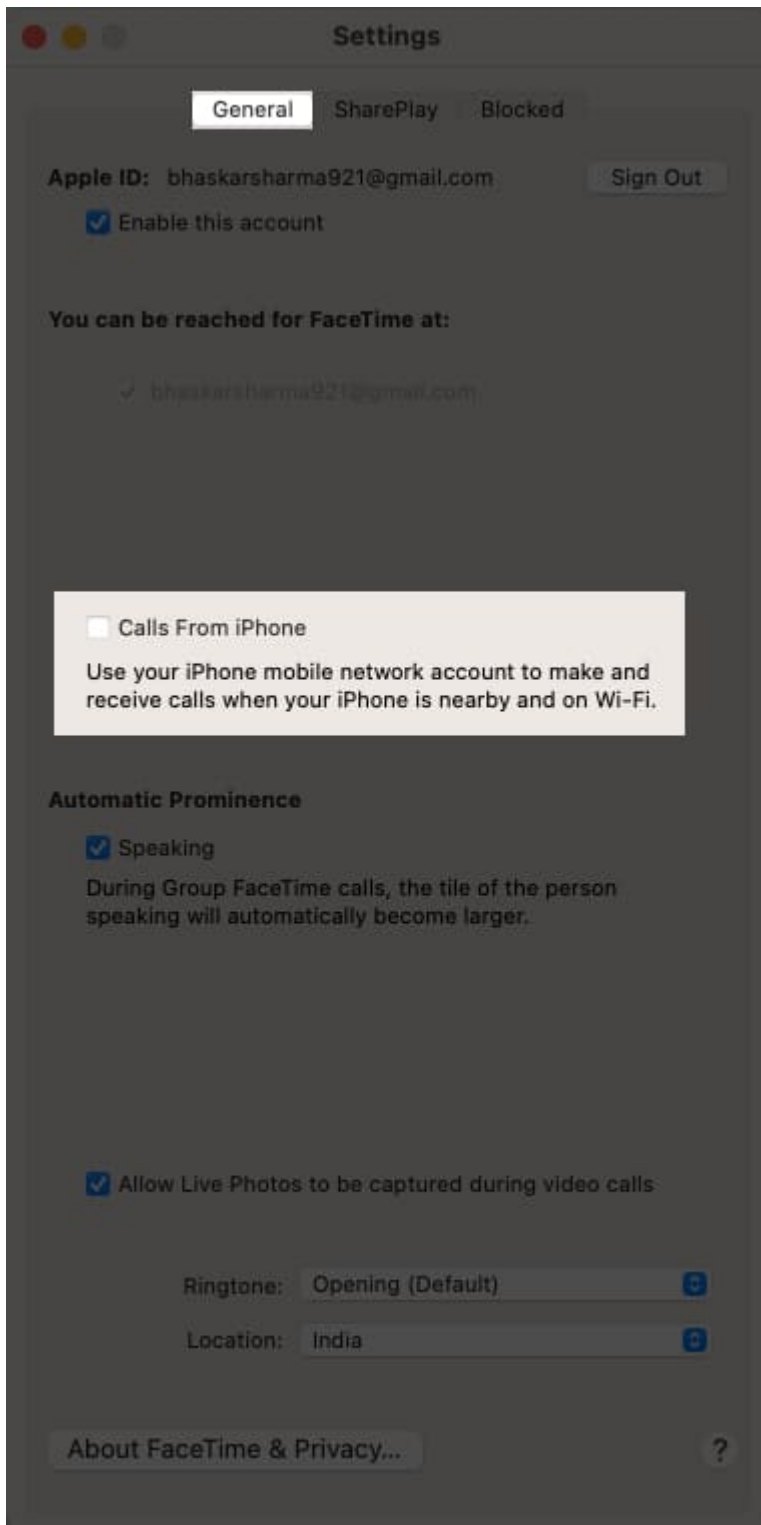
Congratulations on successfully turning off phone calls on Mac, but keep in mind that this is only a temporary solution. To find a more permanent fix, please scroll down below.

How to permanently turn off phone calls on Mac

1. Launch the **FaceTime** app on Mac.
2. Click **FaceTime** on the menu bar → Choose **Settings**.

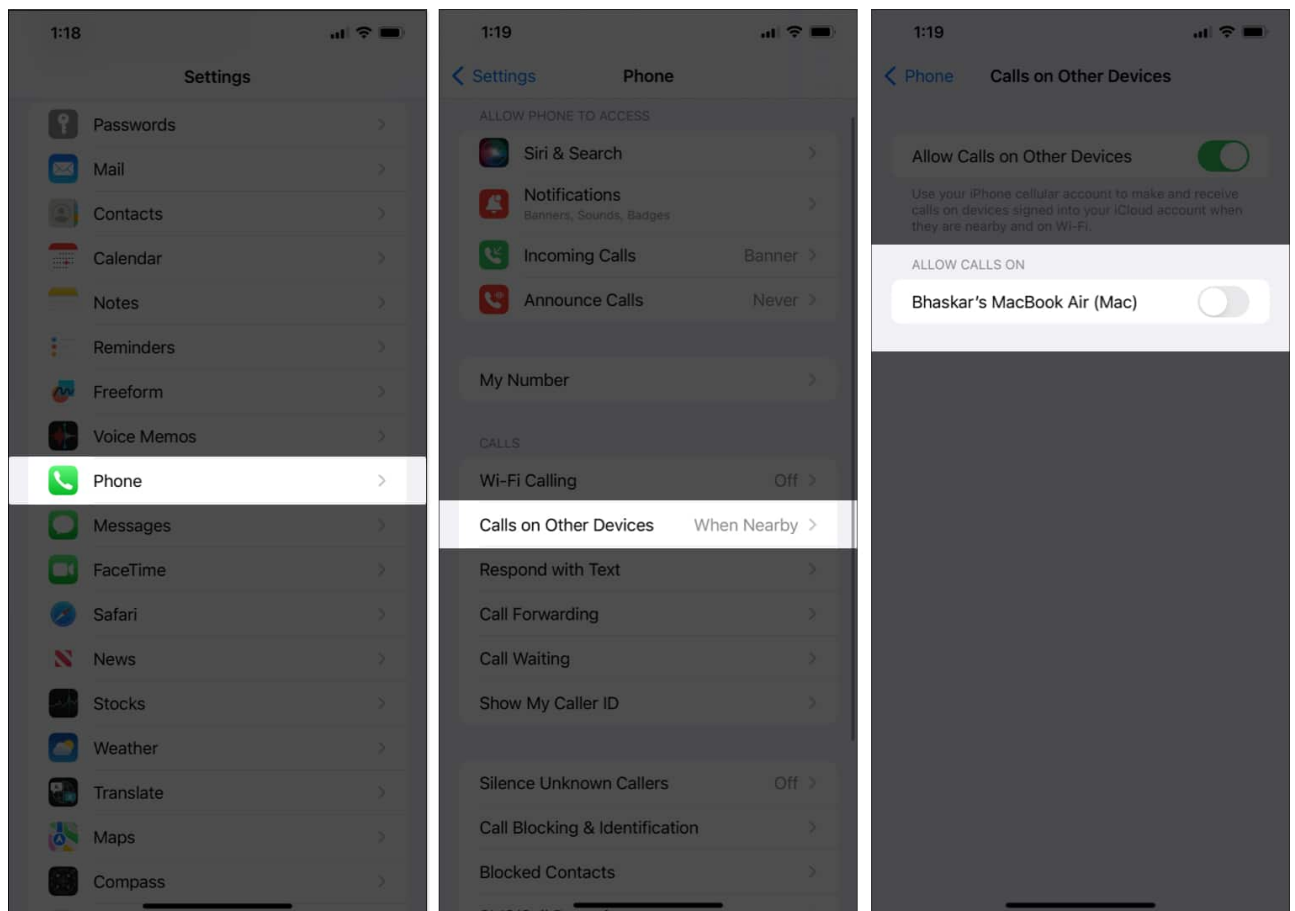


3. Ensure to be in the **General** tab → Uncheck the box next to **Call From iPhone**.



Permanently disable Mac phone calls in iPhone Settings

1. Launch **Settings** on your iPhone
2. Select **Phone**.
3. Tap **Calls on Other Devices** → Toggle off the button next to **your Mac's name**.



FAQs

What happens to incoming phone calls when I turn off Mac phone calls?

The buzzing of incoming calls on your Mac will stop if you disable Mac phone calls. However, your iPhone will still receive calls normally.

Can I turn off Mac phone calls for specific contacts?

Unfortunately, there isn't a set method through which you can disable Mac phone calls for particular contacts. On the other hand, if you disable Mac calls, it will also affect all

incoming calls to your iPhone.
