



# How to Turn Facebook Nearby Friends ON or OFF on iPhone


- 1. Open the Facebook app on your iPhone
- 2. Tap on the **menu** from the bottom right
- 3. Tap on **Nearby Friends** or You may need to tap on **See More** and then tap on **Nearby Friends**.




4. Tap on the **three-dots icon** and then tap on **Settings.**

5. Turn OFF or ON the toggle for **Nearby Friends.** 




For more privacy, you can disable location tracking for Facebook.


## **How to Stop Facebook from Tracking your Location**

- 1. Open **the Facebook app** on your iPhone → Tap on the **menu**
- 2. Tap on Nearby Friends.



- 5. Turn off the toggle for **Location history.**




You can also disable the Facebook app from accessing your location from iPhone settings.

## **How to Turn Off Facebook Location Tracking on iPhone**

1. Open the **Settings** app on your iPhone  $\rightarrow$  **Privacy**  $\rightarrow$  **Location Services.** 



2. Tap on **Facebook** From here, choose **Never.**
