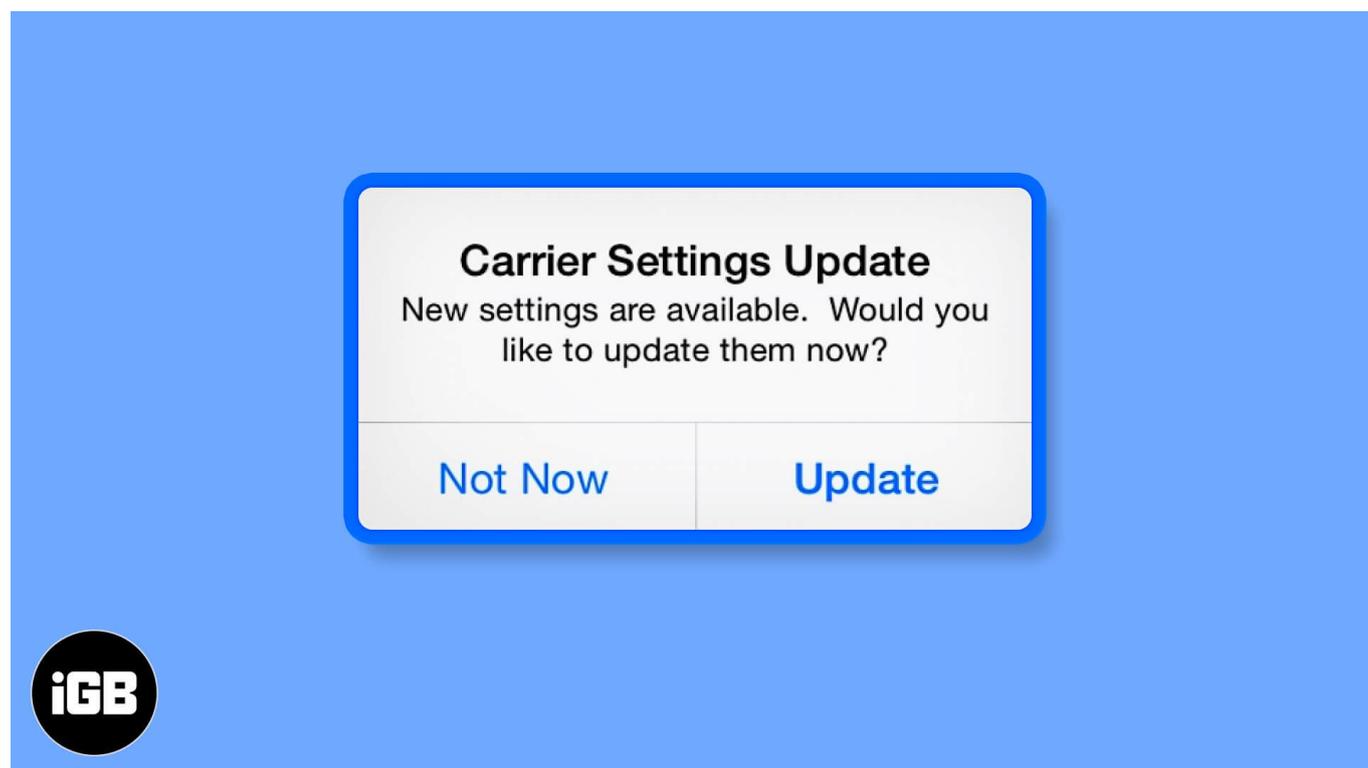

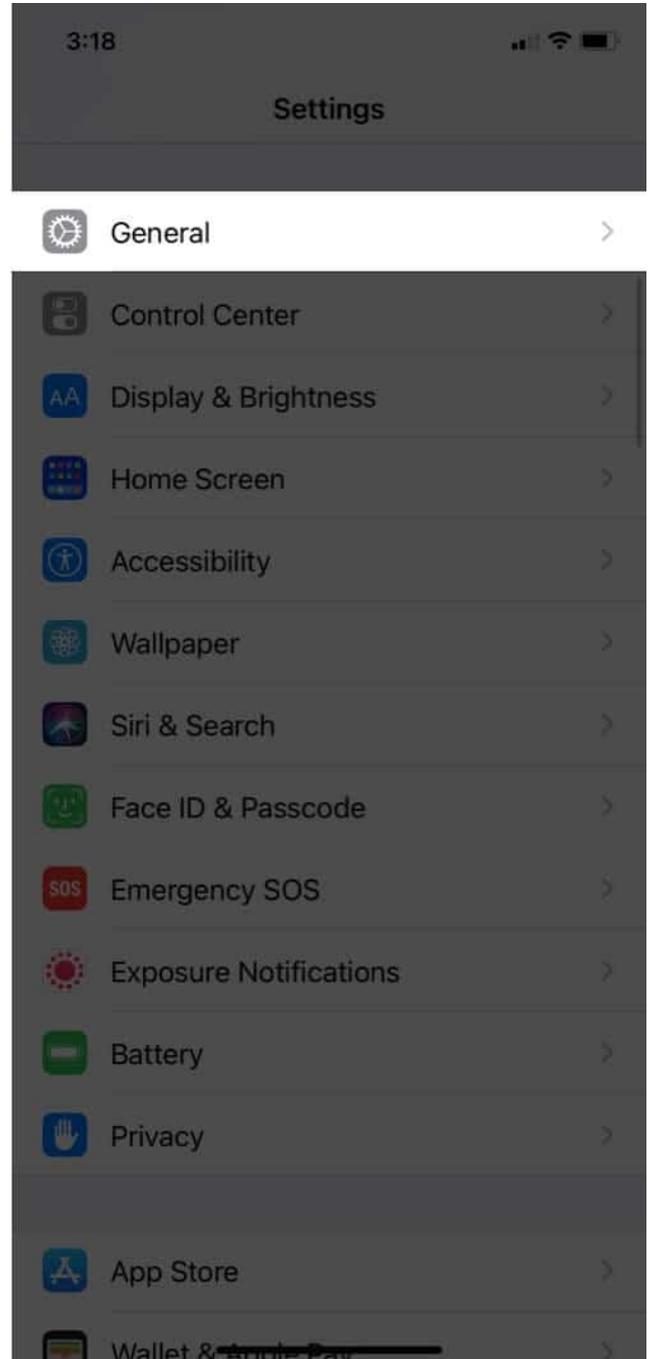
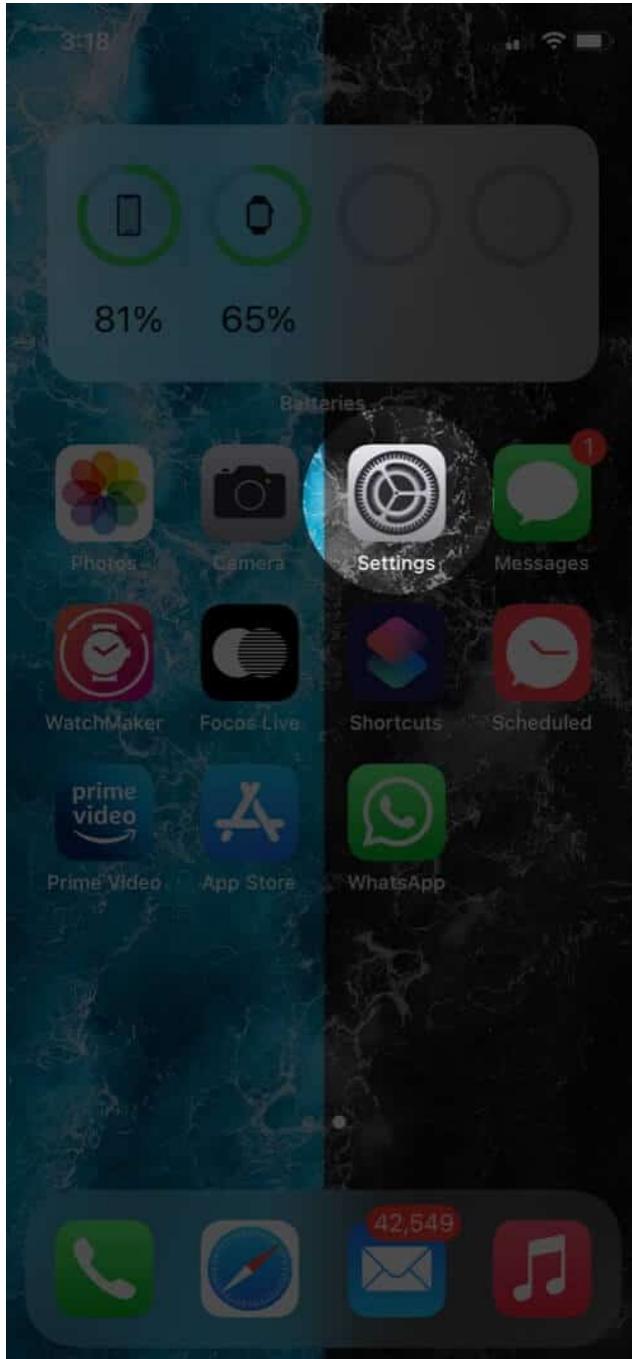
Is It Safe to Update Carrier Settings?

In fact, not doing that might prevent you from unleashing the complete potential of your iPhone in regard to the advanced features of your cellular company.

How to Manually Update Carrier Settings on iPhone or iPad

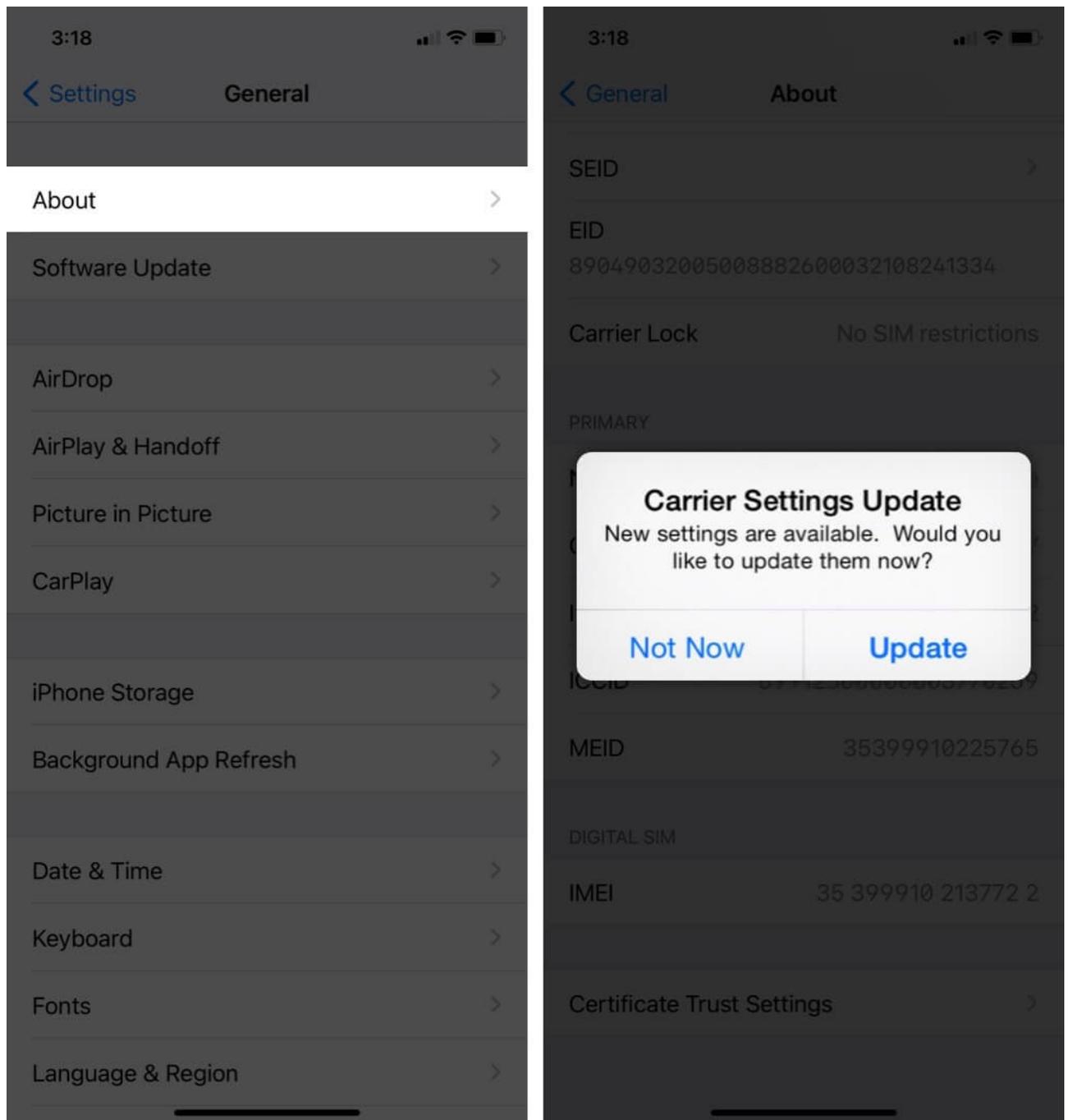
First, make sure your iPhone is connected to a Wi-Fi network or has cellular data turned on.

1. Open the **Settings** app on your device.
2. Go to **General**.



3. Tap on **About**.

4. If an **update** is available, you'll see a pop-up screen that will appear.



Check If iPhone Carrier Settings Are Updated or Not

In case there's any update or a new release, a pop-up should appear by that time. Just to be double sure, you can consider [rebooting your iPhone](#) and checking again. Besides these, here are a few other ways to check updates for carrier settings.

- If your carrier has provided an essential update, you'll see the 'OK' button instead of 'Update' in the pop-up.
- When you insert a new SIM, you need to download the latest carrier settings by following the steps. Go to **Settings** app → **General** → **About** → **Carrier** to check the current version of your carrier settings.
