

The Apple Watch Calculator app allows you to make mathematical computations, split bills, and calculate tips from the comfort of your wrist. All you have to do is enter the total bill amount as well as the number of people, and the watch will do the math. Let's take a look at how to use the Calculator app on Apple Watch.



How to add Calculator app to Apple Watch face

Note: If you happen to uninstall the Calculator app from your iPhone, it is automatically going to be uninstalled from your Apple Watch.

You may add the Calculator app to your Apple Watch face using two ways. Let's check them.

From Apple Watch

Only some [watch faces](#), such as Chronograph, Utility, Modular, Color, and Simple, enable you to add Calculator complications. Let's take a look at the steps:

1. Press **Digital Crown** → tap and hold the **watch face**.
2. Tap **Edit** → swipe to **Complications**.

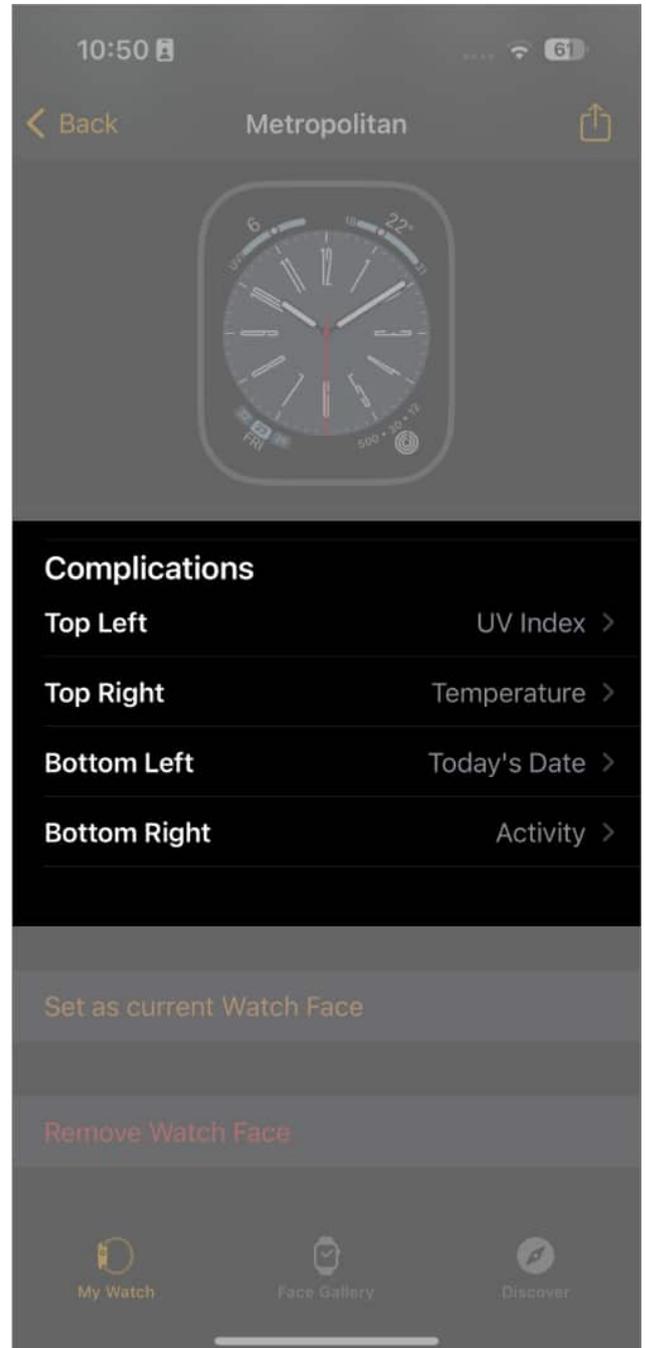
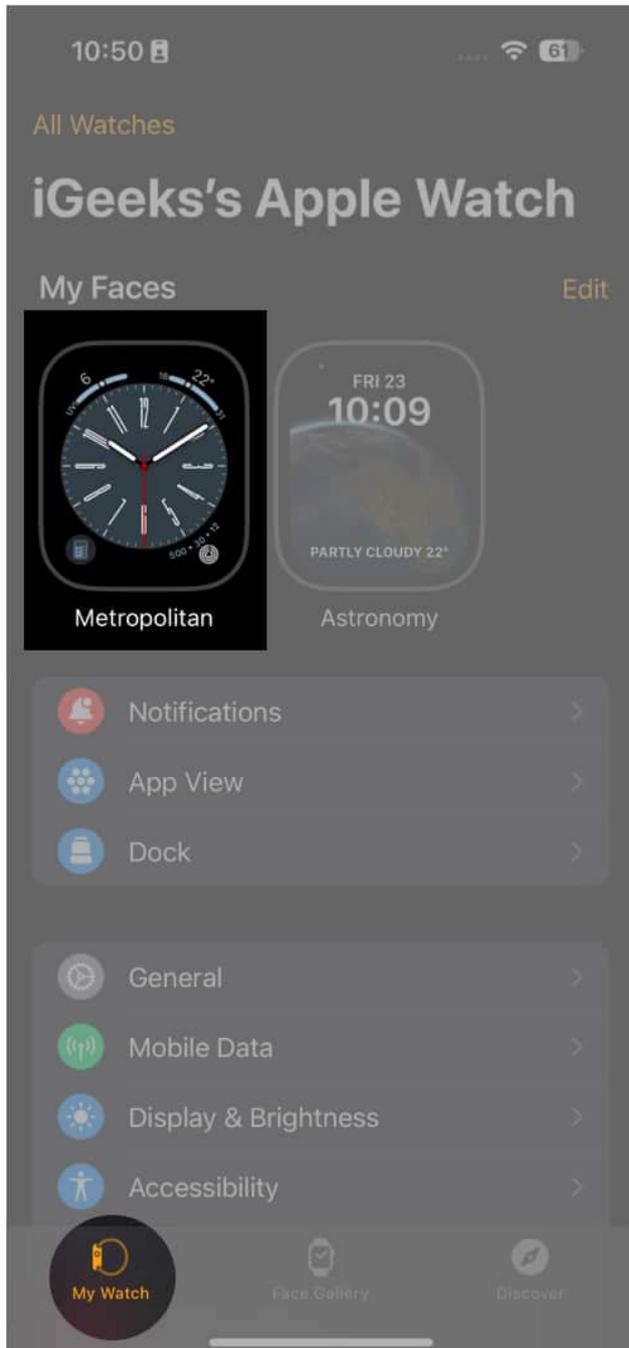


3. Select **a corner** where you'd like to see the Calculator app appear.
I am going with the bottom left.
4. Now, from the options available, select **Calculator** under the CALCULATOR section.
You may turn the Digital Crown to surf through options quickly.
5. Now, **press the Digital Crown twice** to return to the Watch Face.

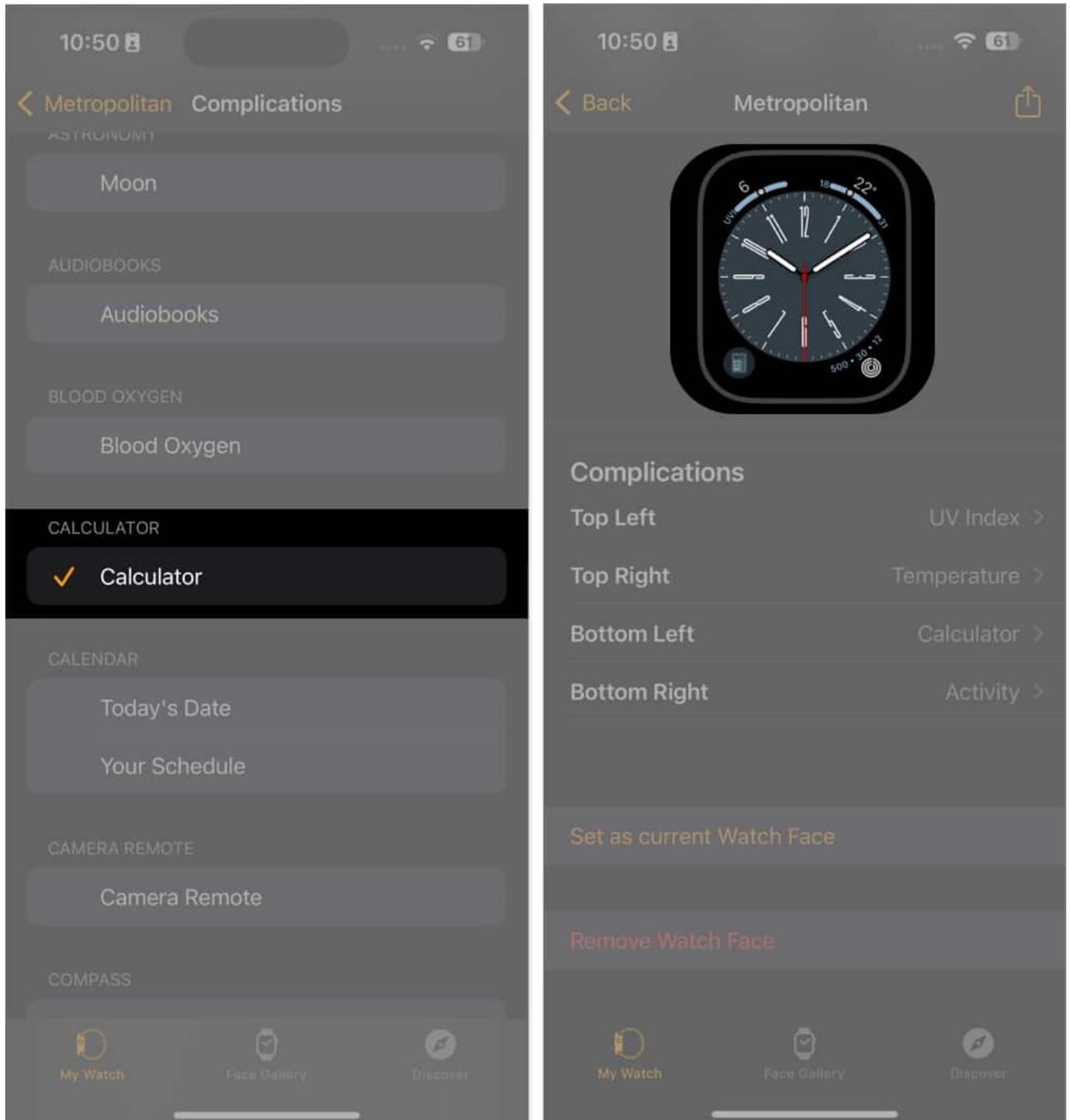


From iPhone

1. Launch the **Watch app** → **My Watch**.
2. Tap the **Watch Face name**.
3. Go to the **Complications** section.



4. Select a **corner** where you'd like to see the battery percentage appear.
I am going with the bottom left.
5. Scroll and tap **Calculator** under CALCULATOR.



Access Calculator app on Apple Watch

Now that you've added the Calculator app on your Apple devices, let's move forward and check how you can access it.

From Watch Face

1. Press **Digital Crown**.
2. Tap the corner with the **Calculator** app, which you set using the instructions above.



From Home Screen

1. Press **Digital Crown**.
2. Go to **Calculator**.



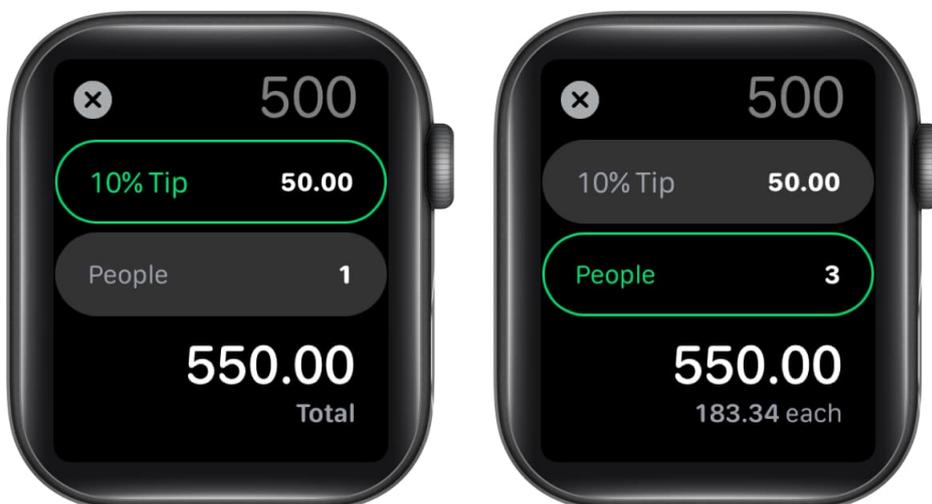
How to Use Calculator app Split Bill and Tip functions on Apple Watch

When going out with friends, you can use the Tip calculator in the app to split bills between friends. Use the steps below to do so.

1. Open the **Calculator** app.
2. Fill in the **amount** of the bill → tap **TIP**.



3. Tap **Tip** and roll the Digital Crown to change the tip percentage.
4. Tap **People** and use Digital Crown to set the number of people.
The maximum number of people is 50.



If the bill is split evenly, you may see the tip amount, the total cost, and the amount each individual owes.

Additionally, if you don't want to do all the manual rigors, you can use Siri for the same.

All you need to do is activate Siri by pressing and holding the **Digital Crown** and ask something like **"What's 7 percent of 500?"**.

Note: Please keep in mind that the Tip option is not accessible in all regions or countries.

Q. Apple Watch calculator tip missing?

Because the tip function is not accessible in all locations, you may not see the tip symbol on your Calculator app on the watch.

Q. Can you get a scientific calculator on Apple Watch?

Yes, you can use your Apple Watch as a scientific calculator. Although there is no mechanism to access it in the default Calculator application, you may always use third-party apps to do so. [Calculator u0026 Math Solver](#) is a good third-party application that lets you utilize a scientific calculator.

Q. How do I add a calculator to Apple Watch Control Center?

No, there is no way to get your Calculator app to appear on your Apple Watch's Control Center.
