

Things to know before using dual WhatsApp accounts on iPhone:

- You can't have two WhatsApp accounts on the same number.
- Get a second active SIM on your iPhone or have it on another phone nearby.

WhatsApp is among the most popular chatting apps across the globe. It is so well-liked that you connect with all your friends, family, and even colleagues through it. Therefore, you may want dual WhatsApp accounts for iPhone to separate your personal and professional lives. But is that possible? Yes, you can create multiple accounts on WhatsApp, but there's a catch. But first, I will explain how to use two WhatsApp accounts on iPhone.



Advantages of having two WhatsApp accounts on iPhone

All of us know how to create and set up an account on WhatsApp using one phone number. But what if you have another eSIM on your iPhone and want to have WhatsApp for that? Meta, per se, doesn't allow two accounts simultaneously on the same device. Also, unlike Android, you can't create a clone app or parallel space on iPhone.

As a result, the only solution to set up 2 WhatsApp accounts on iPhone is to install WhatsApp Business. It's another free WhatsApp version designed specifically for businesses. However, anyone can use it as it performs the same activities as WhatsApp and includes a few additional features. So, you can separate your personal and professional interactions.

Having multi-account WhatsApp allows for more productivity. For example, you may create and turn on the [Focus filter](#) for your personal WhatsApp while at work. Further, you can turn off notifications from WhatsApp Business on the weekends.

Now, let's find out how to use two WhatsApp accounts on iPhone.

How to use WhatsApp Business to set up a second account

If you haven't already, the first step would be to download WhatsApp from the App Store on your iPhone and register an account using your main phone number. After successfully creating the first WhatsApp account, your phone number is tied to the said account. Then it's time to set up a second WhatsApp account on the same iPhone.

1. Download [WhatsApp Business](#) on your iPhone. Meanwhile, ensure your secondary SIM is enabled as an [eSIM on your iPhone](#) or is put into another smartphone you have on hand. It's important since you will get the OTP for logging into WhatsApp Business to that number.
2. After successful installation, launch **WhatsApp Business** and choose **Agree & Continue**.
3. As you already have a WhatsApp account, it will now ask you whether you want to continue using the same phone number for WhatsApp Business. Tap **Use a different number** to create a second WhatsApp account.
4. Now **type the OTP** you got on another number to confirm your registration.
5. Tap **Done** at the top-right corner.
6. If you previously had WhatsApp on that number, you may choose to **Restore Chat History** from iCloud backup and tap **Next**. If not, select **Skip**.
7. Then **type your name** and **set a profile image**.
8. Below that, there's an option for setting your Business category. Choose **Not a business** and tap **Done**.
9. Follow the instructions, set your preferences, and choose **Next**.
10. Tap **Continue** if you receive a popup (the name does not adhere to the rules).
11. Finally, choose **Not Now**.

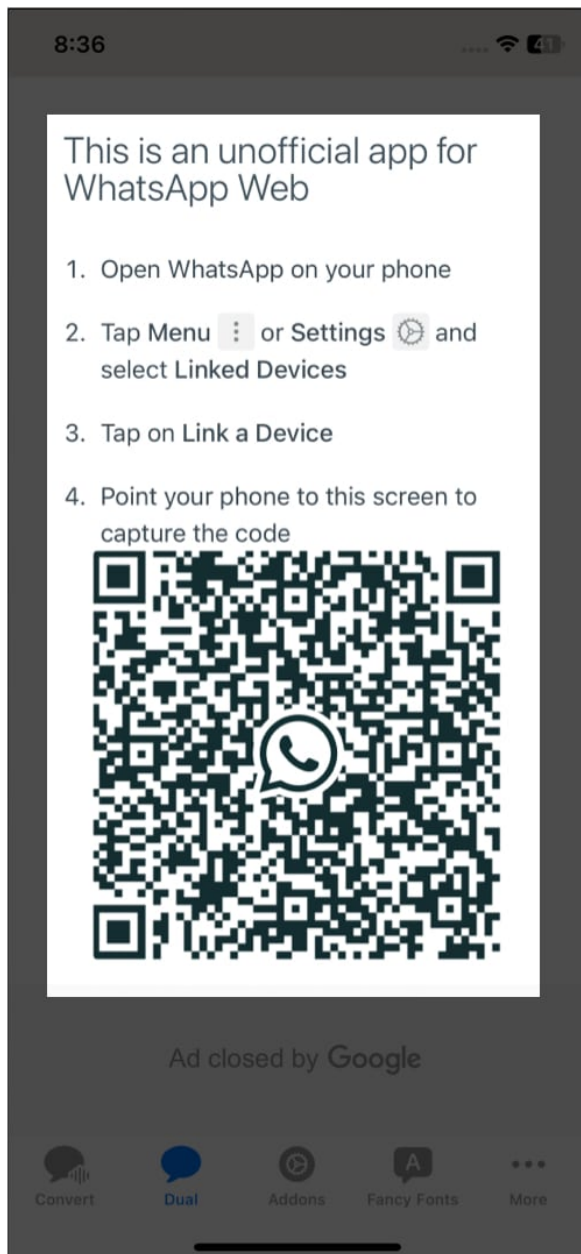
That's it! You now have a second WhatsApp account entirely distinct from your primary account. You may start sending and receiving messages, making WhatsApp calls, and creating groups.

Use Messenger Duo for WhatsApp on iPhone

Note: This method is just a workaround, and you will need two devices with distinct WhatsApp accounts.

There are many dual messenger apps on the App Store that you may use as an alternative to signing up for WhatsApp Business.

1. Download the [Messenger Duo for WhatsApp](#) app on your iPhone.
2. After successful installation, open the app. It will show a **QR code** similar to WhatsApp Web.
3. Get your other device → open WhatsApp → go to **Settings**.
4. After that, to connect your iPhone, choose **Link a Device** and scan the code. Voila!



That's how you can add multiple WhatsApp accounts on your iPhone.

Dual Messenger

This app is similar to Messenger Duo. Here also you need to scan the WhatsApp Web QR code. So, you can use two WhatsApp accounts on your iPhone. Besides, it lets you turn off WhatsApp's automatic picture download, hide Last Seen, change your phone number

without losing messages, etc. Additionally, you can use this Dual Messenger for Instagram, Facebook, Telegram, etc.

The primary drawback of these third-party apps is the volume of advertisements. However, Messenger Duo for WhatsApp app's UI is far more suited for mobile devices than most other messaging apps available on the App Store.

FAQs

Can you have two WhatsApp accounts with one phone number?

Unfortunately, using two WhatsApp accounts concurrently connected to the same phone number is impossible. If you try registering your WhatsApp number for WhatsApp Business, the old app disconnects your number. And all your data and chats will be transferred to WhatsApp Business.
