A regular [waterproof case](#) has a charging port and thus can lend you limited protection say

up to 10-feet underwater. The ProShotCase encloses your device in a transparent heavy-duty case and does not allow even a drop of water to enter. Moreover, the case is built in a way that keeps the device safe and sound during accidental falls, as well.



So, while developed for underwater or aquatic sports, the ProShotCase can be comfortably used while you are biking, trekking, or camping, making the iPhone invincible in the most real sense.

Features Galore:

- **Waterproof down to 50 feet** - Whether you are planning a snorkeling or deep-sea diving adventure, the ProShotCase can help you film the underwater beauty that you see
- **Shock-Proof** - As explained earlier, the ProShotCase protects your device against accidental drops, bumps, and dints
- **Flat lens**- To maintain the functionality and clarity of the iPhone, the case has a crystal clear flat lens in the back
- **Mount-ability** - The case incorporates a connector that allows you to mount your iPhone on the floating hand grip (included in the pack), almost all GoPro mounts, tripods, [bike mounts](#), chest mounts, etc.

- **Touch Screen compatibility** - Despite being fully encased in a glass fortress, your iPhone will not lose its touch screen compatibility. You can use almost all features except charging
- **The tactile sensitivity of buttons** - Both volume and power buttons do not lose their sensitivity and works well even with the slightest of pressure
- **No effect on connectivity** - The case does not hinder cellular, Bluetooth, or Wi-Fi connections
- **Easy installation** - An easy to use locking system ensures a quick and easy installation and removal of the iPhone

How to Insert iPhone into ProShotCase



As mentioned above, it is quite an easy process. Just press the clips on the side to open the bottom part and pull the plate outside. Place your device on the plate properly and push it inside the case. Once in place, the clips will lock automatically, securing your device. The procedure may vary slightly depending upon the device, so read the instructions carefully.

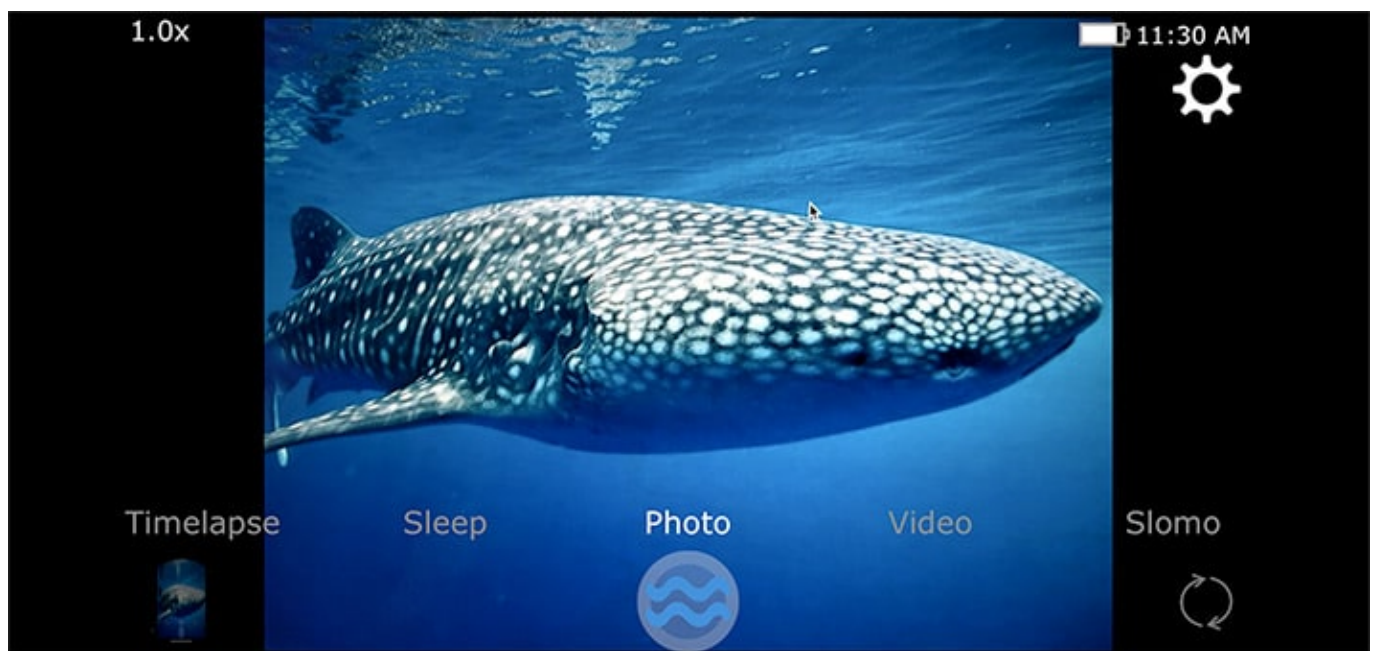
The Underwater Mode - It Works Seamlessly In The Water

I was a bit skeptical about losing certain functionality while using the iPhone underwater. However, a quite intelligent feature in the ProShotCase App successfully cleared up all my doubts. Basically, any touchscreen device loses a part of its sensitivity when wet; now, imagine the pressure of water at that depth.

The iPhone will not be able to differentiate between your touch and water's flow, activating a touch screen control by mistake. Thus the Underwater Mode disables all touch screen controls and gives the primary controls to the volume buttons.

How to Use Underwater Mode in ProShotCase App

Open the **ProShotCase App** and tap on the **Settings icon** from the top right corner. **Toggle On the Underwater Mode**, tap on the **Back icon** to return to the camera. When activated, you will see a **wave pattern** in place of the click button.

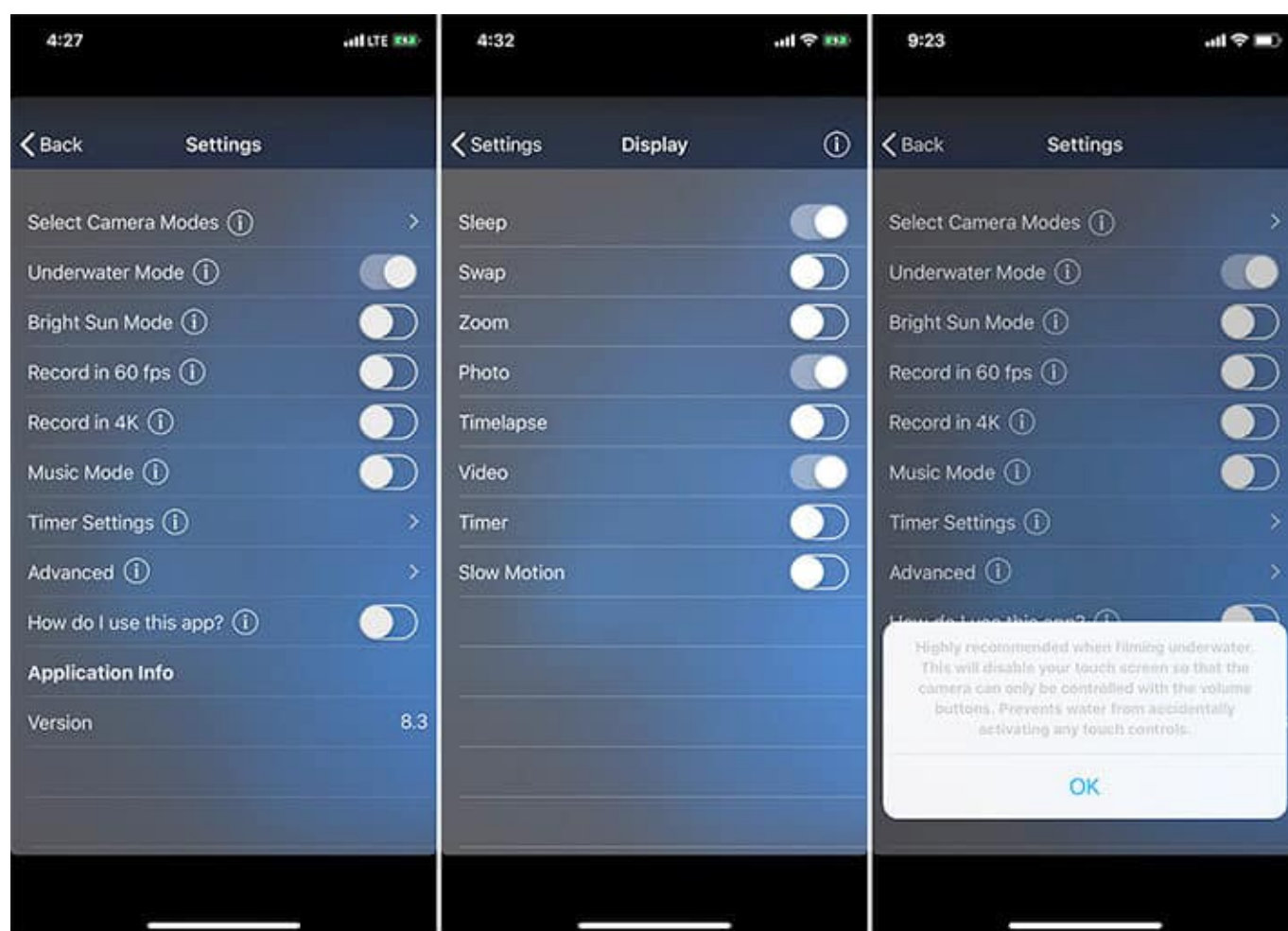


- **Volume -**: This will allow you to switch between different camera modes such as photos, videos, time-lapse, timer, slo-mo, etc
- **Volume +**: When you have the desired mode, this button will allow you to click pictures or start recording

To exit the Underwater Mode, tap on the **Settings icon** again and **toggle Off** the mode.

ProShotCase App: A Complete Camera App

Outside water, you can also employ the native camera app or any other [iOS camera apps](#) you want to use. However, ProShotCase App provides many other features that can be used both over and underwater. Including some regular features such as Record in 60 FPS, Record in 4k, Timer Mode, Time-lapse and Slow-motion, and some unique features that are mentioned below in detail.



To access these modes tap on **Settings icon** and toggle on or off as per your choice. To access more camera modes, tap on **Select Camera Modes** and toggle on or off the modes you want on the camera's screen-swipe section.

- **Sleep** - As the name suggests, this will send your device to sleep to save battery when not in use. You can touch any volume button to wake the camera instantly
- **Bright Sun Mode** - Visibility is usually compromised under a bright sun; this mode

ensures you can easily see camera modes by adding a black banner under them

- **Music Mode** - The mode enables you to listen to music via Bluetooth while using the ProShotCase app. However, if recording video, the audio will not be recorded in this mode

What I like most about the app is that apart from this special mode, it also includes elementary functions as well, such as swap and zoom.

Why Should You Go For ProShotCase

ProShotCase is a perfect companion for Aquaphile, travelers, sports enthusiasts, photographers, videographers, YouTubers, Instagramers; in short, whosoever is an outdoorsman. What's great is that you don't have to rely on expensive and heavy gadgets to capture your trips and activities.
